The Department of Insurance, Ottawa, has undertaken the publication of a bulletin with a view of calling public attention to the rapidly increasing fire waste in Canada. It is generally felt by the Dominion and provincial fire officials that to deal effectively with the situation the general public must be aroused to a greater sense of individual responsibility for existing conditions. It is a lamentable fact that besides the millions of dollars worth of property destroyed every year, statistics show that 2,600 persons have perished by fire in Canada during the last ten years. The bulletin gives many valuable suggestions along the line of fire prevention.

THE GLOBE'S LOGIC (?)

The Globe is greatly exercised because the Drury Government placed a tax of five per cent on racetrack betting, and collecting the tax from the winners. The Globe points out that the Government gets a larger rake-off than do the jockey clubs.

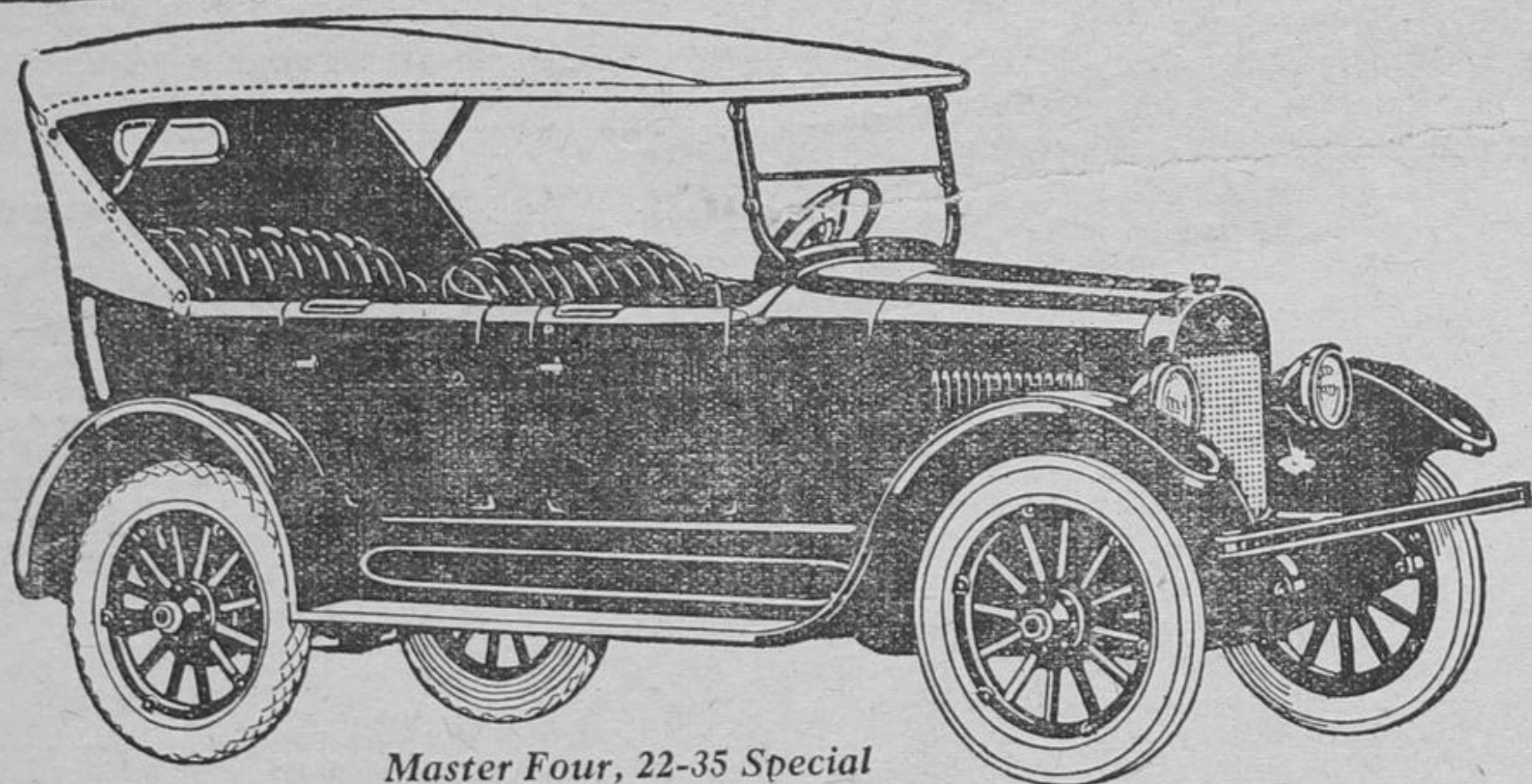

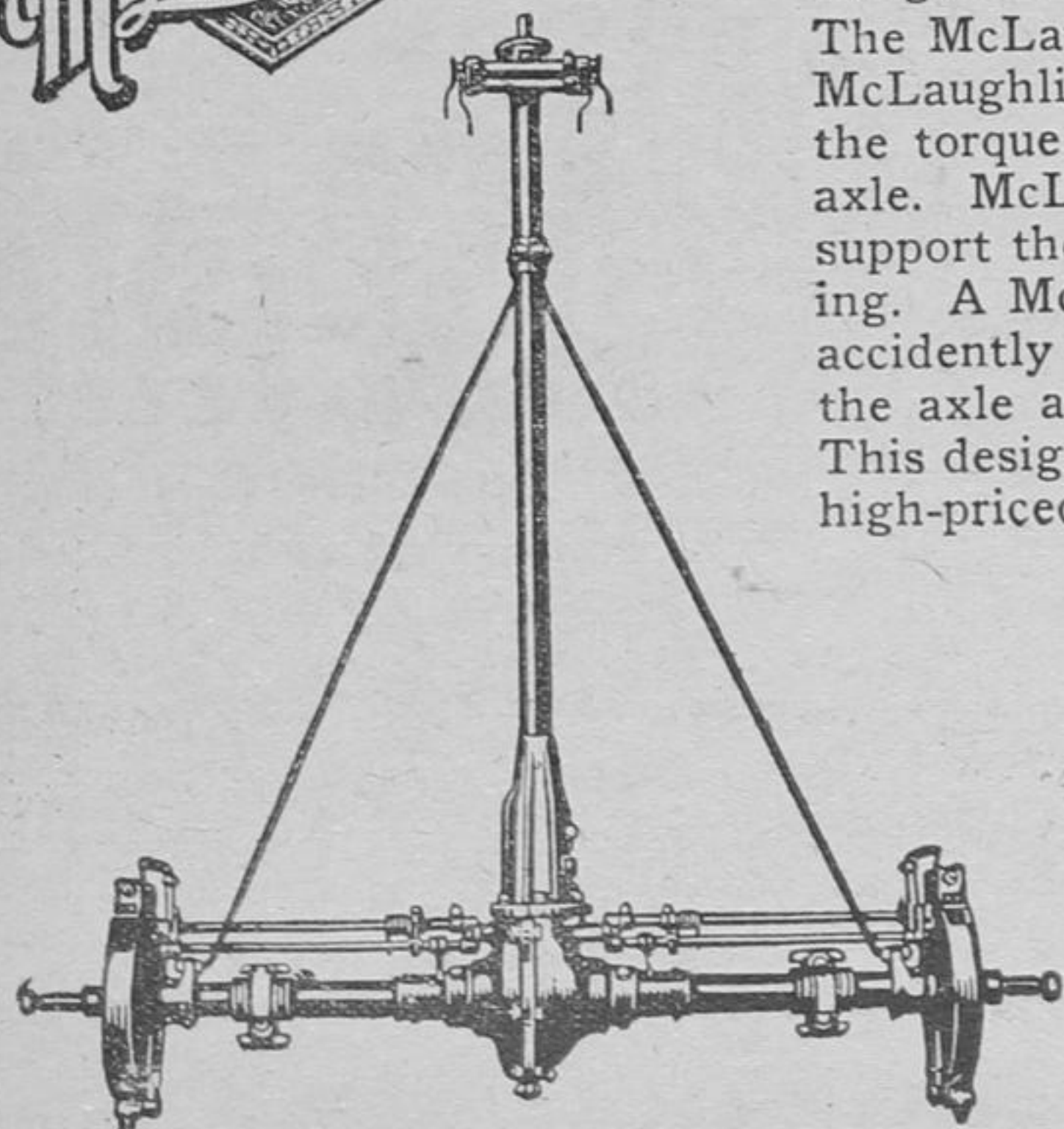

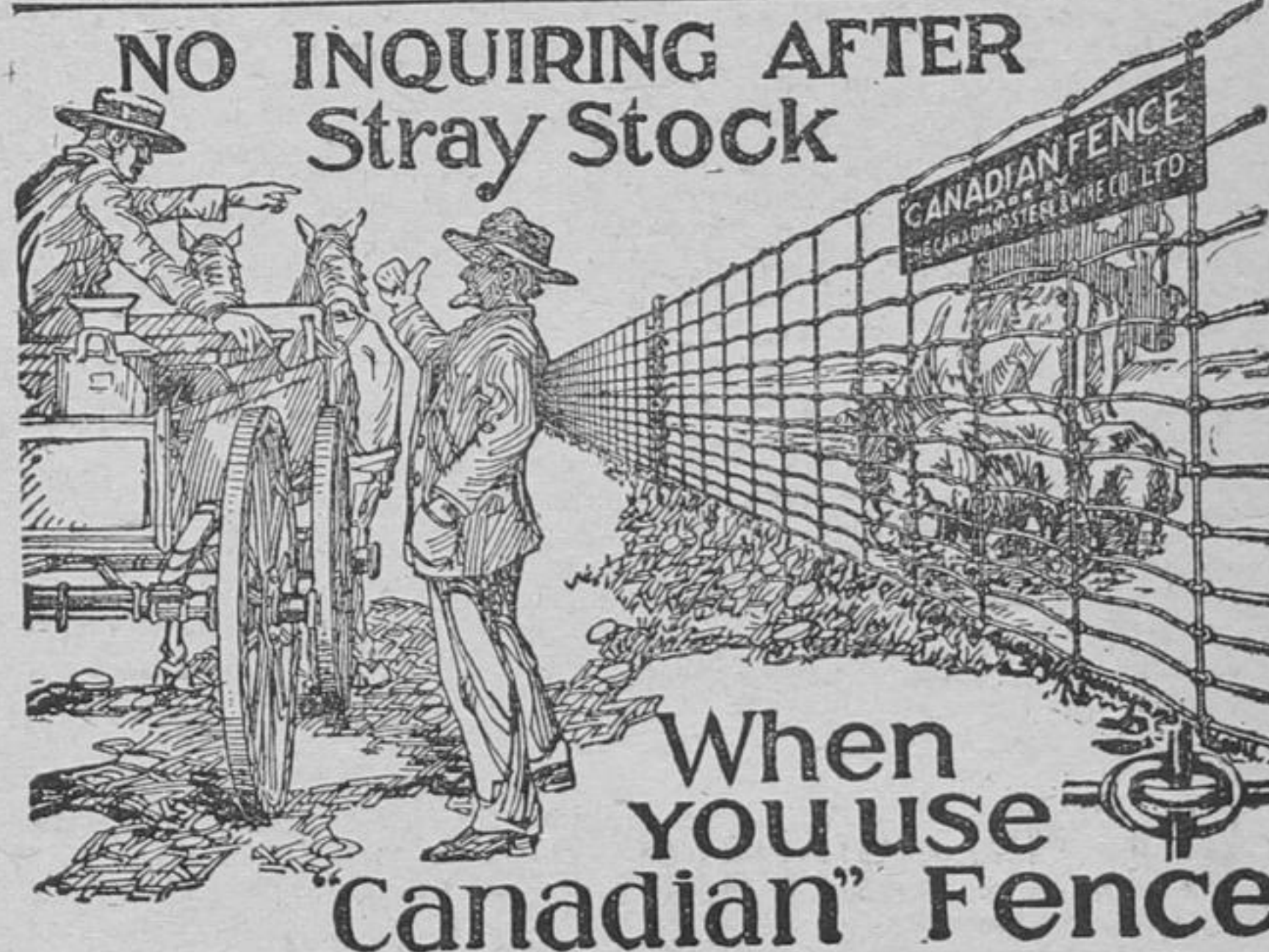
