GENERAL RULES OF MANUFACTURE  
Color of Wood shall be No Defect.  
XXX-6/2-16—  
Six butts to measure not less than 2" when green. Must be strictly clear, vertical grain, smoothly sawn and otherwise well manufactured. No sap or shims allowed. Random widths but no shingles narrower than 3". When dry 25 courses shall measure not less than 8".—To be continued.
