Mr. Henry made a lengthy fight for the bill, c'aiming it was a measure of reform. The bill met with much opposition from all sides of the house, but was finally sent to committee where it will likely be killed.

Although the Ontario Temperance Act was passed in the Legislature by a Conservative Government, now that they are out of power it is hard to find any Conservative speaker saying a good word for it. Judged by utterances from the two or three political parties it seems that the contest now being started will be to a great extent between the drys and th · wets.

Mr. Drury, Mr. Raney and other members of the Ministry are unflinching in their efforts to enforce the V. T. A., Mr. Hay, the Liberal leader has promised his support, but Mr. Ferguson, leader of the Conservatives, is saying little about the measure. His Conservative supporters are, however, speaking out plainly, showing a preference for the old license law and the open bar.

Mr. E. W. J. Owens, one of the aspirants for a Conservative nomination in Toronto, is one of the last to show his colors. In addressing Ward 6 Conservatives the other evening he praised the old license law, and showed his preference for "a decent, good glass of grog which would e'evate and make men joyous," rather than the present boot-leg poison.

Mr. Owens, however, is not to be condemned for coming out and showing on which side he stands But let these who believe in temperance and moral reform not be deceived.




