One of the measures of general in-
terest introduced in the Legislature
stood in the name of Hon. George S.
Henry, who would have County
Councils composed of Reeves only.
The office of Deputy-Reeve would be
abolished under this bill, which also
provides that in County Councils a
man representing a municipality of
under 1,000 population would have
one vote; under 2,000, two votes, and
over that four votes. Mr. Henry
made a lengthy fight for the bill,
claiming it was a measure of reform.
The bill met with much opposition
from all sides of the house, but was
finally sent to committee where it
will likely be killed.

Although the Ontario Temperance
Act was passed in the Legislature by
a Conservative Government, now
that they are out of power it is hard
to find any Conservative speaker
saying a good word for it. Judged
by utterances from the two or three
political parties it seems that the con-
test now being started will be to a
great extent between the drys and
the wets.

Mr. Drury, Mr. Raney and other
members of the Ministry are un-
flinching in their efforts to enforce
the O. T. A., Mr. Hay, the Liberal
leader has promised his support, but
Mr. Ferguson, leader of the Con-
servatives, is saying little about the
measure. His Conservative supporters
are, however, speaking out plainly,
showing a preference for the old
license law and the open bar.

Mr. E. W. J. Owens, one of the
aspirants for a Conservative nomi-
nation in Toronto, is one of the last
to show his colors. In addressing
Ward 6 Conservatives the other even-
ing he praised the old license-law,
and showed his preference for "a de-
cent, good glass of grog which would
elevate and make men joyous,"
rather than the present "boot-leg
poison."

Mr. Owens, however, is not to be
condemned for coming out and show-
ing on which side he stands. But let
those who believe in temperance and
moral reform not be deceived.

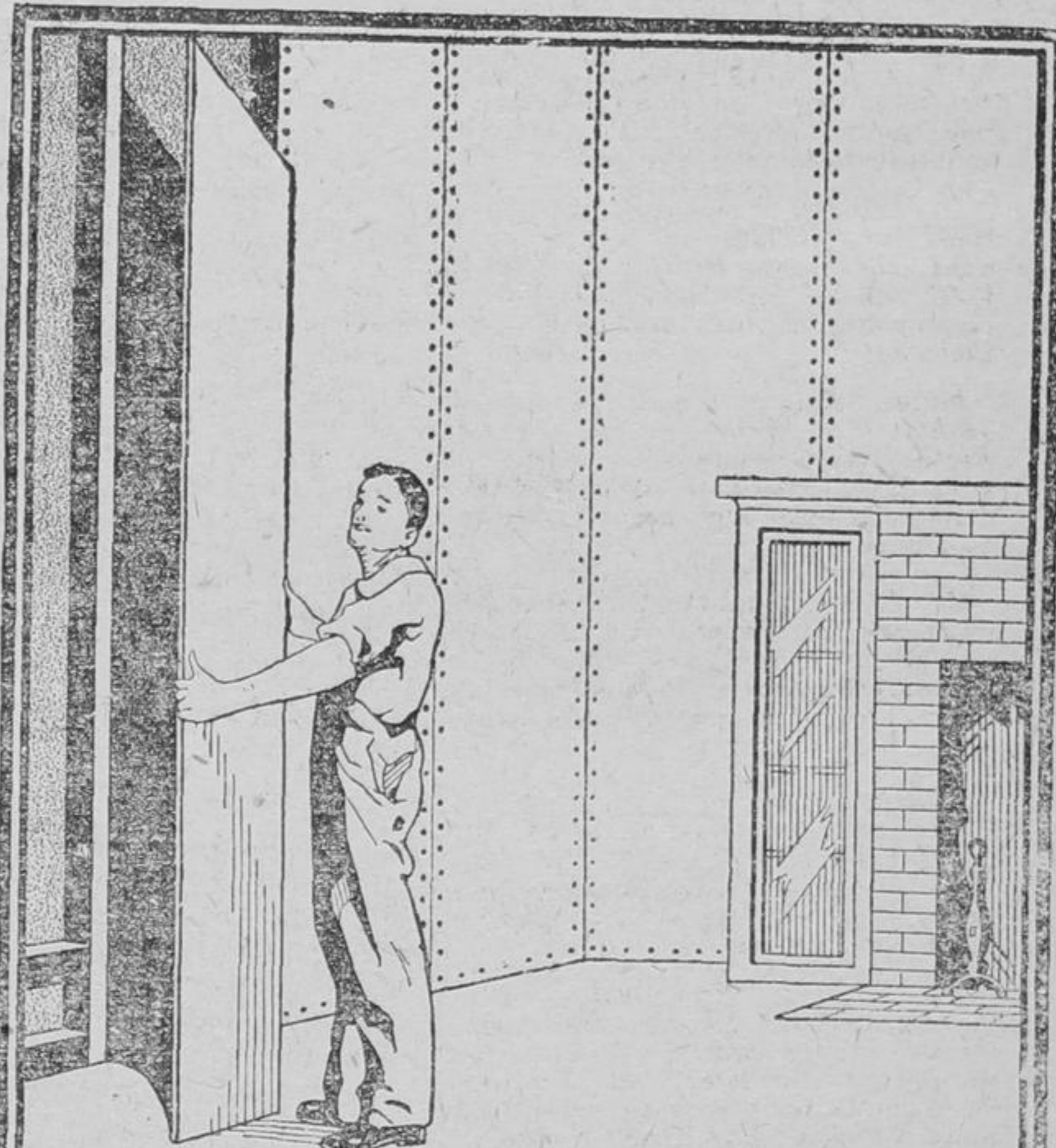

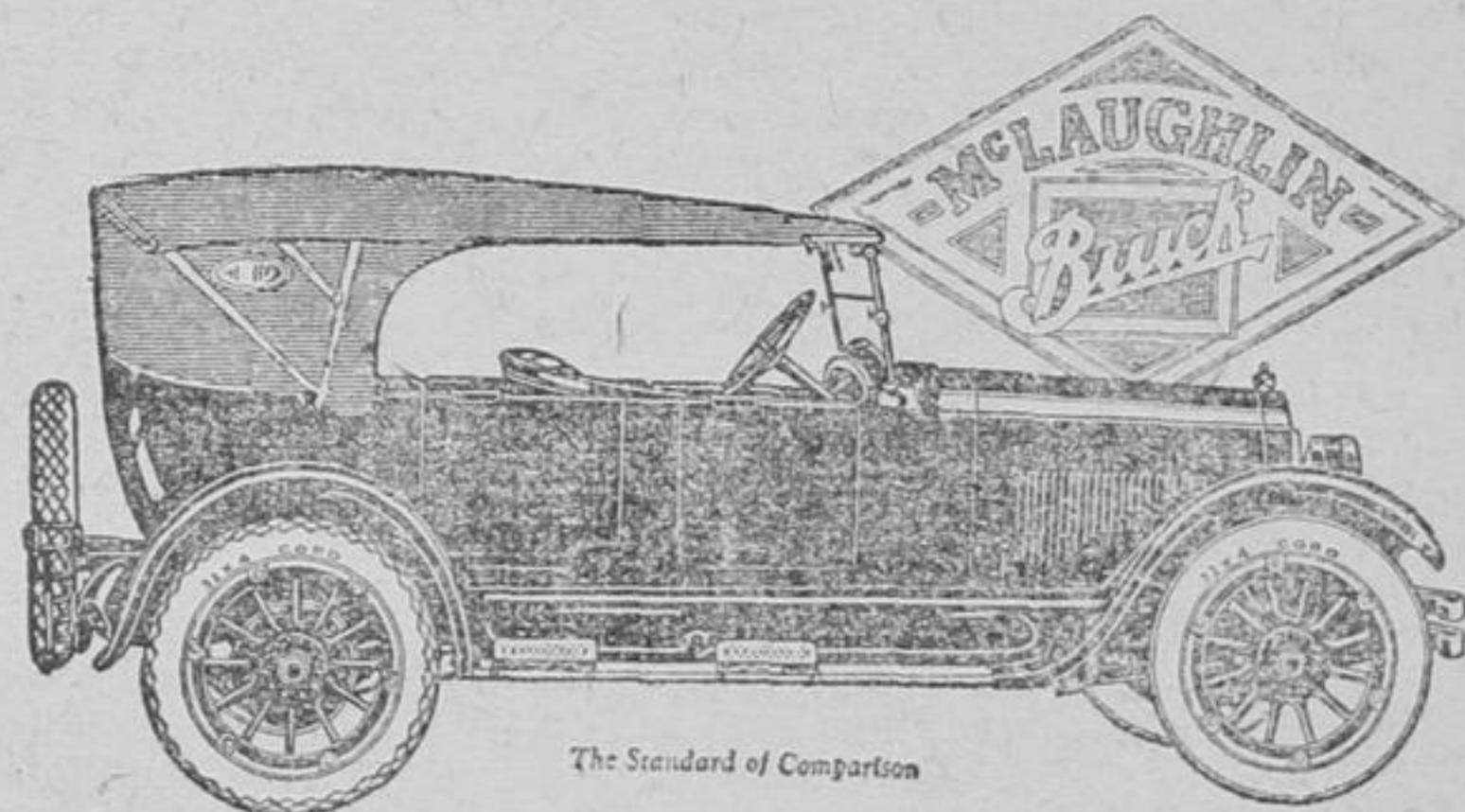
