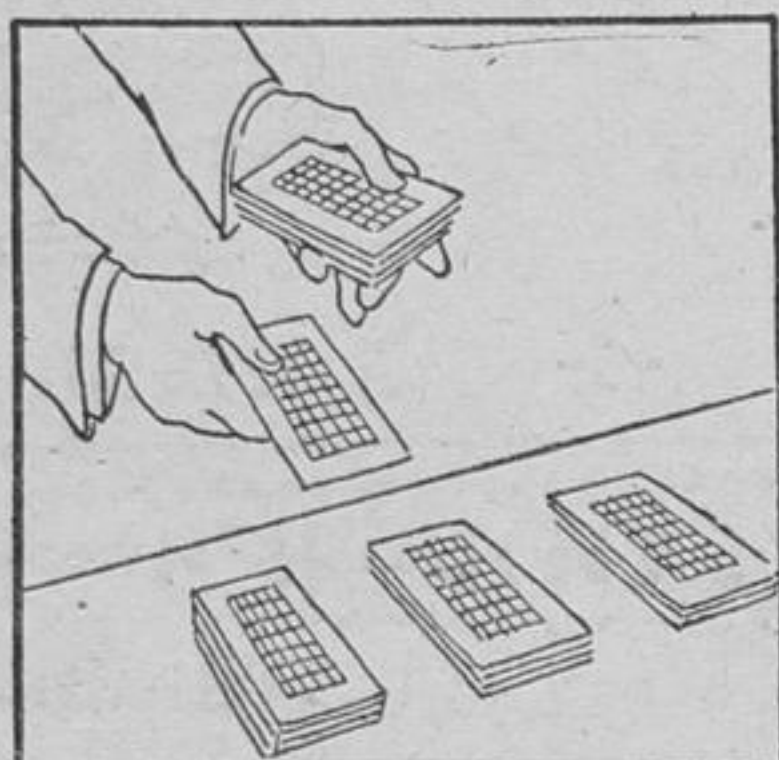

EASY TRICKS

No. 32

The Triple Deal



This is an easy but effective
card trick. You will need 21
playing cards. Ask a friend to
observe the cards as you deal them
on the table and mentally to select
any card he likes. Impress upon
him the fact that you do not in
any way influence his choice.

Deal the cards one at a time
into three heaps, showing the face
of each card as you place it on its
heap. Ask your friend to tell you
into which heap his card was
dealt. Pick up the cards with ap-
parently careless but really be
careful that the heap containing
his card goes between the other
two cards. Repeat twice (three
deals in all) each time putting the
heap containing the selected card
between the other two.

Show that neither the top card
nor the bottom card is not the se-
lected card. Put the cards behind
your back. Quickly count eleven
cards from the top of the pack.
The eleventh card will be the card
selected by your friend.

This trick is the same in effect
(but different in method) as the
trick described several days ago
as "The Three Piles." By doing
the trick twice, using a different
method each time, you will puzzle
the astute spectator who thinks he
knows "how it is done."
