settlement of European affairs. Mr.

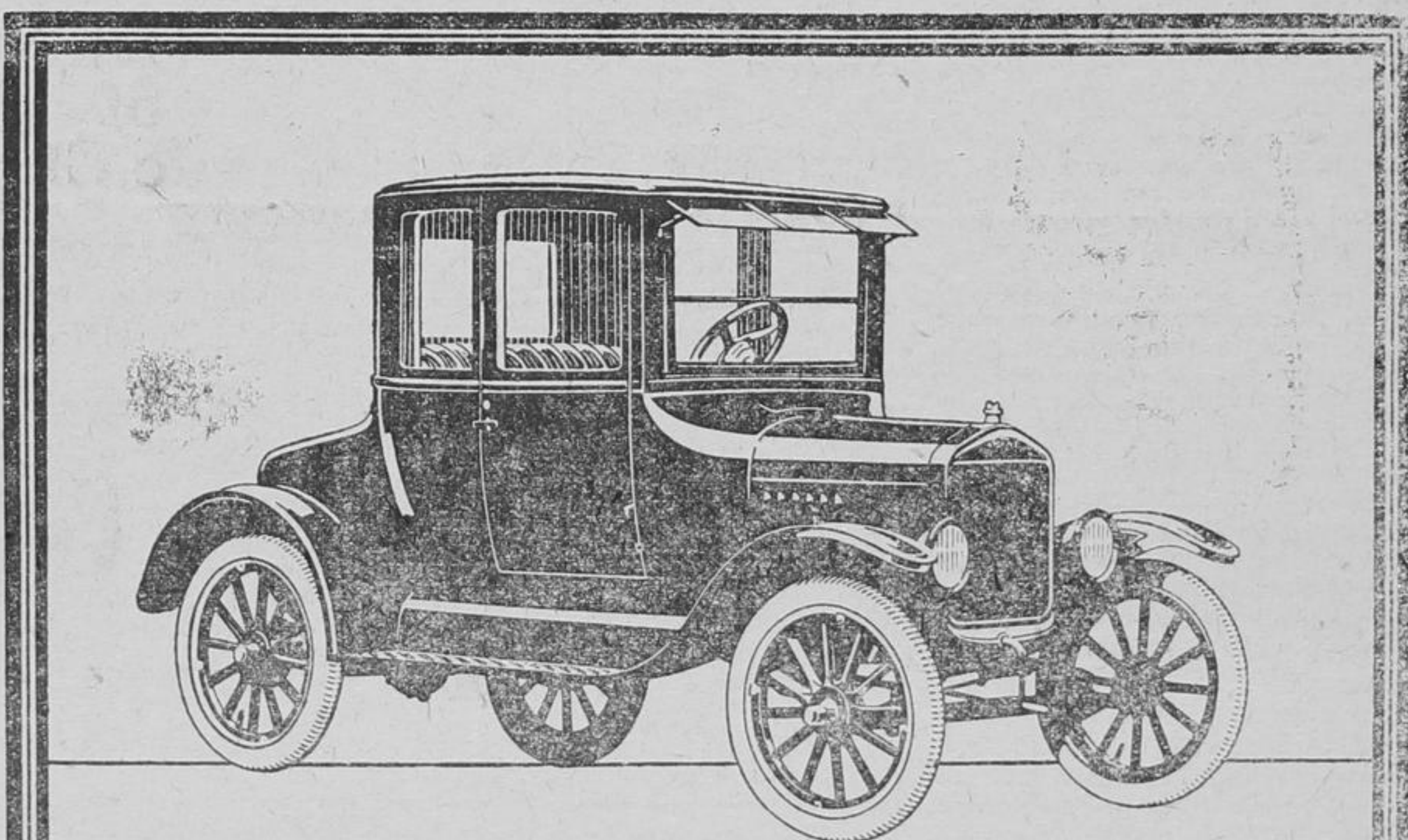
