Farmers Motor Excursion

A conference was held last week at Richmond Hill, consisting of prominent young farmers and the Agricultural Representative, to complete plans for a Motor Excursion to the Ontario Agricultural College on June 13th. A special two day programme has been arranged during the Semi-Centennial week, especially for farmers, featuring a gigantic live stock parade, floats and department displays, experimental plots, gardens, poultry and college authorities in making the day pleasant and educational.

The motor party from York County will meet at Wallace Street, Woodbridge, at 8.30 a. m. standard time, on June 13th, and proceed via Brampton for Guelph. Luncheon will be provided free at the college, leaving the afternoon free for sight seeing. The Junior Farmers who have organized the excursion, extend an invitation to everybody interested in Agriculture, to attend. For parties of ten or more travelling by train, fare and a half rates are offered. Guelph is fifty miles from Woodbridge, and under favourable conditions the motor party should arrive at Guelph by noon.
