The New Agricultural Pessibilities

To The Editor of The Richmond Hill Liberal

Dear Sir:-In a mill called the Jay-Bee or Humdinger Mill. I suppose the mills name originated through the inventor's name being J. B. Sedberry. It was on exhibit at Exhibition by W. H. Morley.

I had been trying hard to locate a machine of this nature for over a year and finally found one, but to my surprise, beat anything I had ever expected of it. It does the work so much better than I had expected, and not only that but it does so many more stunts that you would think it impossible for the one machine to do.

If I had been running this mill I would have called it "Three in One," as it will thresh grain, and pulverize and that is that we handle the straw and the grain all in one operation. In saying this I mean any barley, cats or wheat can be put properly cured timber. Now if you through at just as it comes from the field, and you can make it all into fine meal, you can make all your alfalfa and all your grain into pig-feed if you so desire. If you want it a little coarser for cattle or even coarser for horses you can adjust it that way also.

It will pulverize anything, even wood or stones as fine as wheatine for the baby. It is impossible to show the merits of this machine by writing. If I could not get another one like it, I would not take two thousand dollars for the one I purchased.

I also think that this machine has come in at the right time, as there are so many growing sweet clover to put nitrogen in the soil, but have had considerable trouble with it on account of the coarse stalks. This machine has solved the trouble, as it will grind it into meal and I think there will be a great deal more sweet clover and alfalfa grown when they get a few more of these machines installed in the
