Yonge Street Should Be Paved This Year.

Provided that certain amendments to the Highways Act pass the Provincial Legislature at the present session it is expected that Yonge Street in Richmond Hill will be paved this year. The proposed amendment will provide that the Province pay seventy-five per cent of the cost of construction of the pavement. The total cost would probably be in the neighborhood of \$25,000 or \$30,000 which would make the village responsible for about \$6,000 or \$7,000.

The road is in a deplorable state and is in such a condition that the annual expenditure for upkeep under present conditions promises to be a large item. It is therefore quite apparent that an expenditure of six or seven thousand dollars which would be taken care of by the issuing of debentures and would not be too heavy a burden for the taxpayers, is the logical solution. Richmond Hill would then have a main street which instead of being a bone of contention and decided draw-back to the town would be a credit to the municipality and leave a good impression with the thousands of people who pass through every year.

Reeve Lunau accompanied by councillors Ballock and Herrington interviewed the department of Highways last week and it is understood that it is a foregone conclusion that the amendment will pass the house as it is sponsored by the government. The members of the council are quite favorable to the proposition and as soon as the enabling legislation is brought down it will be immediately brought up for consideration. When paving was considered previously the estimated cost for the village was somewhere in the neighborhood of forty thousand dollars which covered cost of curbs and gutters which had to be built. It is understood that there will be no proviso whatever in the present legislation regarding the work which must be done by the village.

It has also been intimated that the T. T. C. will be approached with a view to having them move the radial tracks to the centre of the street which with ten feet of pavement on either side would make an admirable main street for Richmond Hill. As it is apparently the intention of the T. T. C. to change the gauge this spring the time seems opportune for making this suggested change which would be a great boon to the appearance of the street as well as a convenience for traffic.

The proposed amendment to the Highway Act is as follows:—
"Where it is deemed by the Minister as desirable and expedient an agreement may be entered into with the corporation of an urban municipality for the construction therein by the municipality or by the Department of any highway which is a connecting link or extension of a provincial highway.

The proportion of the cost agreed upon but not exceeding in the case of a town fifty per centum, and in the case of a village seventy-five per centum, of the cost of the work to the extent of twenty feet in width of the travelled portion of the highway shall be paid out of the Fund and the remainder shall be borne and paid by the urban municipality.

A road shall not by reason of its having been constructed or improved under such section become or be the property of the Crown, but every such road after its construction or improvement shall be under the jurisdiction of the council of the municipality in which it is situated and shall be maintained and kept in repair in the same manner as other roads in the municipality."

the present 300 listed varieties had all originally sprung from the two old types, viz., Alba Flora (white) found in Siberia and Rubra (red) found in Southern Europe. The speaker claimed that the peony next to the rose was the most widely known and favorite flower. It even surpassed the rose for mass formation effects and was less trouble to grow because disease and insect pests are almost unknown to it.

In planting the following points were important for the best results. (1) Plant in the open so that the root will receive plenty of air and sunshine. (2) Dig the hole 3 feet every way if possible but plant the root itself shallow with the crown not more than 3 inches below the surface. (3) Choose a root with plenty of small fibres.

(4) Place a layer of pulverized manure at the bottom of the hole and work well into the soil, but do not let the fertilizer touch the root or root fibres. (5) Loosen the ground around the plant in the spring to admit the air. (6) Supply the plant with plenty of water just before the blooms burst.
