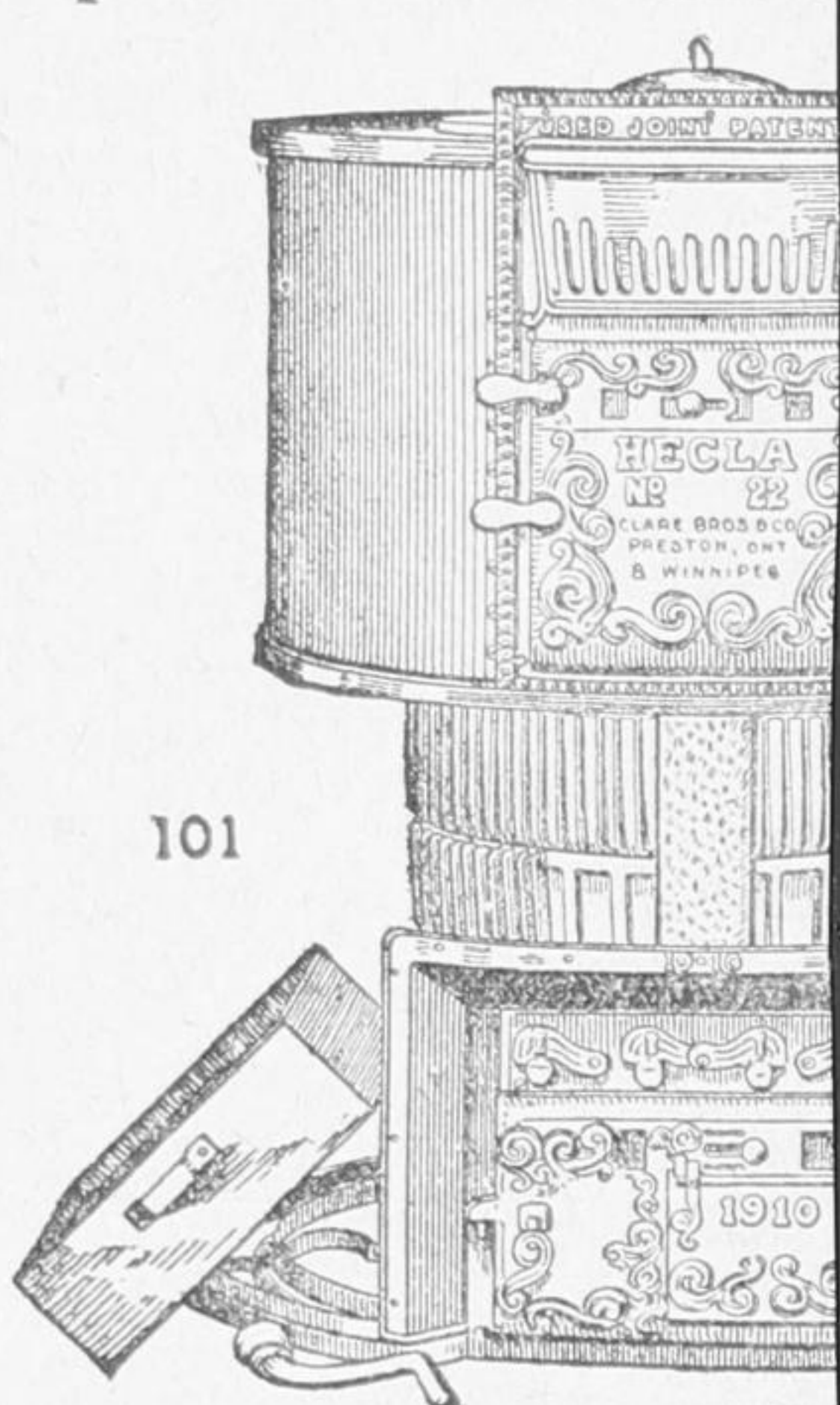

Mr. Bowles was asked by the pulpit supply committee to write to Mr. Jackson, to ascertain if he would be open to consider such a proposal, and a favorable reply was received, but before formal action was taken by the board to invite Mr. Jackson, a committee waited upon the General Superintendent, Dr. Carman, and laid the case before him, stating as a difficulty in the way that Mr. Jackson was not a member of Toronto Conference and seeking direction as to how it might be arranged to have Mr. Jackson come to us and still remain a member of the British Conference. Precedent of somewhat similar action was quoted in the cases of the late Rev. Dr. Punshon and of Professor Maggs.

The General Superintendent suggested that a minister of Toronto Conference might be appointed Superintendent of Sherbourne Street Church and Mr. Jackson recognized as stated supply. Dr. Carman at that time gave expression to no apprehension of danger to this church or the church at large, by reason of this doing violence in any way to the Connexional order, nor did he say anything in discouragement or disapproval of the plan.
