Ratepayers of Markham Township. A meeting of the Ratepayers of Markham Township and also others who may be interested in the Road problems of the Township will be held in the Council Chambers at Unionville on Saturday morning at 10 a.m., April 9th. Mr. J. M. McVicar, C. E., District Engineer of the Department of Public Highways will be present and will address the ratepayers on the Highways of the Province of Ontario and the general condition of the roads throughout the various municipalities.

**Markham Township Notice.**  
Public Notice is hereby given that said Act provides that during the months of March and April in each year, vehicles operating or objects being moved over or upon a public highway, which is not within a city or separated town, and having a carrying capacity exceeding one ton, shall not be loaded in excess of one-half the rated carrying capacity of such vehicle or object without a permit as provided by said Act. The Act also provides that notwithstanding such permit, the owner driver or operator of such vehicle or object, is responsible for any damage caused to a highway by such vehicle or object. A penalty not exceeding \$100 is provided for a contravention of any of the provisions of said Act. Notice is also hereby given that the provisions of the said act will be strictly enforced with respect to the highway under the jurisdiction of the Township of Markham. Road Commissioners are hereby instructed to watch their respective sections for overloaded vehicles, according to said Act, causing damages to the Township Roads, and act accordingly. W. C. Owners and harborers of dogs in the Township of Markham, are requested to have the money ready to pay the license fee and procure tags for 1927 from the assessors (A. J. Camplin, east half; and J. A. Thompson, west half), when they are called upon. The license fees are as follows:— For each dog the sum of \$1, if only one and \$4 for each additional dog; \$4 for each bitch, if only one, and \$6 for each additional bitch. Under the provisions of the Act, an extra charge of 25c. will be made for license tags if payment is not made before April 15th; and further, owners or harborers of dogs not reporting same to assessors are liable to severe penalties for not taking out licenses for same, and the dogs subject to be destroyed.
