HOUSEHOLD HINTS

If pies do not bake well on the bottom, put a hot stove cover under each pie when putting it in the oven.

Fine grained tapioca added to wheat cereals, one half tapioca and one half wheat cereal, makes an excellent breakfast dish.

If you want pastry to be light and flaky, roll in one direction only. If rolled first in one direction and then in the other it is sure to be tough.

To clean a stove pipe, place a piece of zinc on the coals of a hot stove. The vapors arising from this will carry off the soot by chemical decomposition.

Glass of pictures and showcases is cleaned with alcohol. Wring cloth from hot water, dip in alcohol, and polish. Wipe glass immediately with tissue paper.

Strips torn from sheets rolled tightly into little rolls and pinned up come in handy. Bandages average from two and a half to three yards in length, very narrow ones being best for toes and fingers, wider ones for arms and legs. Bandages should always be rolled and pinned until needed.

Seasonable Recipes

A genuine cool-off desert on a warm day must be tart enough and sweet enough and cold enough or capricious summer appetites will not be tempted.

Mint Cooler

Chop one bunch of fresh mint and cook it twenty minutes in one and one half cups of boiling water; soften two tablespoons of gelatin in a quarter of a cup of cold water; strain the mint liquid into it, add three-fourths of a cup of sugar, and when the gelatin is dissolved a quarter of a cup of lemon juice, one cup of shredded pineapple and a little green coloring. Pour into sherbet glasses, thoroughly chill and serve with whipped cream.

New Lemon Jelly

To two and one-half cups of boiling water add one cup of sugar and four cloves; bring to boiling and boil two minutes. Remove from the stove and add two tablespoons of granulated gelatin softened in one-half cup of cold water and one-half a cup of lemon juice. Cover and let stand until nearly cool. Strain half the mixture into a brick mold, which has been dipped in cold water to the remaining half add the white of an egg beaten very stiff, one-half cup of diced fresh pineapple and one-fourth of a cup of raisins cut up or currants. Fill the mold with the second mixture and chill thoroughly. When served garnish with candied lemon peel cubes.

Georgia Peach Cream

Soak two tablespoons of gelatin in a quarter of a cup of cold water for a few minutes, then add to it a cup of boiling water, two tablespoons of sugar and two cups of fresh peaches chopped fine. Stir until the gelatin is dissolved, then set aside. When it begins to congeal fold in the whipped cream, pour into a wet mold, chill and serve with crushed peaches as a sauce.

Butterscotch Delight

Boil half a cup each of brown and white sugar, two tablespoons of butter and half a cup of water together to 240 degrees (or until it forms a soft ball in cold water.) Pour over two stiffly whipped egg whites and chill. Fold into half a pint of whipped cream with one and one-half cups of either shredded fresh pineapple, crushed peaches or strawberries and a teaspoon of vanilla. Soak one and one-half teaspoons of gelatin in a quarter of a cup of cold water, then melt over hot water and add to the mixture. Beat thoroughly and chill for two hours in the icebox. Serve garnished with preserved strawberries.

Grapefruit Snow

Wet three tablespoons of corn starch with a little cold water, stir this into a pint of boiling water and cook until clear. Mix the strained juice of one grapefruit with a cup of sugar stir it into the hot mixture, let boil up once and pour it upon the well whipped whites of three eggs, beating lightly as it is poured. Turn into wet mold, chill and serve with cream or a sauce flavored with grapefruit.
