

HE Ford car fuel system is simple because it is direct. Gravity flow does away with forced feed. A short feed line with a minimum of elbows and connections is easy to service and eliminates approximately 100 parts required by the vacuum tank or fuel pump system.

The nine gallon tank is so placed that it is well protected from front or rear end collision. Any overflow runs off on the ground with no serious results, since the only point of possible spark contact is the rear end of the exhaust. Three screens instead of one, as in most fuel systems, prevent foreign matter reaching the tank. A solid steel dash separates the Ford gas tank from the engine.

The gas guage on the dash of the Ford car is controlled by a simple float as shown in diagram, being more direct, simple and accurate than any other type. Another point of driving convenience made possible by the gravity flow system is the ease with which the tank may be filled, while the driver supervises the operation without moving from behind the wheel.
