**THIRTY YEARS AGO**  
From Our Issue of Dec. 21st, 1905  
The funeral of the late Joseph Cox of Thornhill took place Saturday afternoon at Thornhill Cemetery, and was largely attended. The funeral service was conducted by the Pastor, Rev. J. A. Grant, assisted by Rev. G. McKinley.

The following officers were elected at the annual meeting of Markham Township Conservatives held at Unionville: T. W. Underwood, President; W. H. Stiver, E. Kirk, W. Carruthers, Vice-Presidents; R. J. Allen, Sec.-Treas.; Chairmen of Divisions: No. 1, Stuart Wilcocks; No. 2, Geo. Newbery; No. 3, Frank Bliss; No. 4, F. Frisby; No. 5, A. Weighill; No. 6, W. Carruthers; No. 7, T. McCauley; No. 8, A. Cole; No. 9, G. A. Mitchell; No. 10, W. Armstrong; No. 11, Geo. Bowers. A resolution endorsing the action of the Government with respect to the administration of the license law was carried unanimously. Short addresses were given by Mr. A. McCowan, M.P.P., and others.

Last Friday, about 1 p.m., the fire alarm sounded and it was soon discovered that The Creamery on Arnold Street was on fire. The fire engine was soon on the scene, but water was scarce and the fire was in a short time beyond control. Most of the movable furniture and a good part of the machinery were saved, but the buildings were burned to the ground. The buildings were owned by Mr. A. McLaughlin of Woodstock, and the machinery and contents by Mr. A. Hopkins & Son. Everything was well covered by insurance and Mr. Hopkins will rebuild again.

The annual meeting of the Centre York Liberals was held at Thornhill on Thursday afternoon. The meeting was well attended and passed a resolution protesting against any further increase in tariffs. All of last
