*"Please take good care of your Telephone!"*

A damaged telephone may be hard or impossible to replace—repair parts are scarce and material for new equipment has gone to war. So please guard your present telephone with extra care. Here, for instance, are six common causes of damage:

### AVOID THESE MISTAKES:

1. Never place your telephone on the wall box or on a narrow shelf. Keep it on a wide, firm table or desk.
2. Be careful that the cord does not loop over the drawer handle or knob. Opening the drawer may pull the telephone over; closing it may pinch and damage the cord.
3. Keep your telephone cord unkninked—twist or kink may injure the wire and necessitate replacement.
4. When painting, protect your telephone with a cloth or paper. When washing floors or get soaked with water.
5. Always replace the receiver carefully. Banging it down may injure the delicate mechanism inside. (Be sure it is placed correctly on its support; too, to avoid causing a "busy" signal.)
6. If you have dial service, please do not use a pencil or other sharp point when dialing. It disfigures and damages the dial and often causes a wrong number as well.

Ice disappeared from Lake Couchiching Friday, April 30th just thirteen days later than last year, reports the Orillia News Letter. There have been later seasons, for instance 1904 when the ice didn't go out until May 4th. The earliest on record was in 1921 when the ice disappeared March 31st.

**RADIAL REVENUE STILL GOING UP**  
Report on the operation of the North Yonge Radials for the first quarter of 1943 show an operating profit of \$5,545.62 compared with an operating profit of \$4,452.24 in the same period last year. Revenue for the three months was \$40,304.77, an increase of \$13,899 over the first three months of last year, a gain of 52.64 per cent. Operating expenses jumped more than \$13,000 compared to last year owing the report says to increased mileage operated, cost of snow removal and wage adjustments. Richmond Hill's share of the first quarter's profits was \$1,275.49. Markham and Vaughan Township each received \$610.02.
