Store Window To Aid Potato Crop Smaller Crops Branch States

> Although considerably smaller than last year, 1949 crop of Ontario potatoes is of exceptionally good quality, the Crops Branch, Ontario Department of Agriculture reports. For this reason potato supplies for winter months can be stored with safety under

proper conditions. Only one case of blight disease was reported, by a network of crop observers covering the province. during the entire summer of 1949. The lone case was in a remote area in Northern Ontario and result-

ed in no actual loss. If growers give proper care to harvesting their crops, there should be a minimum of mechanical injury, thus overcoming loss in grading.
