Markham Councillors Express Opinion Water Commission Might Be Desirable

A deputation from Markham Township Council will go to North York Township Council in an endeavour to assure a continuing supply of water for the German Mills area, it was decided at the meeting of the former body held last Saturday. Fearing that a new well being brought in by North York Township in the area would rob their wells of water residents of the district have already petitioned North York asking for an agreement that if this happens that township will assure them of a water supply from the new well. "These people have a right to be concerned," said Councillors Chas. Hooper and Alf. James, pointing out that a serious situation might easily occur.

A promise to have density of population on the Langstaff section of No. 7 Highway checked was contained in a letter from the Deputy Minister of Highways. Under the covering act, he said, thirty mile speed limits could be established only where population in proportion to area reached a certain point. "I think that is not always carried out," said Councillor James, referring to areas where a speed limit of thirty miles was in force although the districts were not built up to the required extent. "I believe that the time has come when we should set up our own water commission, said Councillor Hooper during a debate on water problems in the township. He referred to the fact that municipal machinery to handle collections and other related matters would have to be set up when the new water system in Elmwood Park was finally set up. Also, he stated, residents of Highland Park sub-division were paying for services through the extra charge imposed on water secured from North York Township and that this money might as well accrue to Markham Township. "There will be other sections in the same position as we go along," he added.

"I agree," said Councillor James. "If we have to do it for Elmwood Park we might as well do it for the whole thing."

"Wouldn't it be as well for us to have someone experienced come in and tell us just what is involved?" asked Reeve Win. Timbers. Councillors spent some time discussing township engineering, with some expressing the belief that the time was close at hand when the municipality would save money and be more efficiently served if it had its own engineer, or at least shared the services of an engineer with a neighbouring municipality.

"Superstition" Trustee Told In Debate As School Site Expropriation Discussed

With the Board's solicitor present trustees of Richmond Hill Public School spent a considerable amount of time at a special meeting held last Monday in discussing expropriation of land for a new school on the Hausman property at the northern village limits.

Trustee Len. Clement continued his opposition to expropriation proceedings, asserting that other sites were available, although he was not able to name them to fellow-trustees. "Anything might happen," he stated, referring to the international situation and suggesting that a new school might not be necessary. Chairman Jas. Pollard, trustees Langstaff and Butlin pointed out the overcrowded condition of the existing school, making it necessary even at the present to accommodate classes in the Municipal Hall.

"That's simply superstition," Trustee Clement was told when he asserted that "bad luck" would follow the school if the land was expropriated.

The board decided to defer action for a further short period in order to make a last attempt to see if other sites were available, even though they agreed that an exhaustive search had already been made.

Former Local Hockeyist Joins Maple Leaf Team

A former Richmond Hill hockey player joined the ranks of the professionals last Saturday night when Bob Hassard signed a contract with Toronto Maple Leafs.

Hassard, a Toronto boy, played on the forward line with the Hill team some years ago, first in the minor bantams and then in the bantams in the Toronto Hockey League.
