## Elmwood Park Is Anxious For Water Service

The following letter has been forwarded to the Markham township council by the Elmwood Park subdivision Ratepayers' Association.

1. We must draw your attention to the fact that we have received no reply to our letter of March 17, 1951, which contained our request that the water area be enlarged to that called for in our letter of January 11, 1950 and our July 12, 1950 petition, namely—Markham Road to Palmer Avenue. We understand that, while this matter has been discussed some time ago with the Township Engineers, nothing definite has been recommended by the Engineers or decided upon by the Council.

This disregard of the real area requiring water, and of our petition (which was sufficiently signed, in our estimation) cannot be condoned. Our association, the Council and the Engineers are coming in for some heavy criticism. May we have the Council's decision and plans as quickly as possible please.

2. It is indeed very hard to believe that an extra set of plans is not available from the engineers. If you request them to send us a copy, I am sure that they will heed your instructions. Possibly the profiles would not be required, but there is no reason whatsoever why we cannot have a copy of the area plan at least.

3. We are very happy to note that the contractor is proceeding with the work now that the ground is getting drier, and we feel that it is certainly about time we were advised of in regard to the details of connections to the houses. These questions have been asked before, always with your answer that the Council had not made any decisions regarding these details.

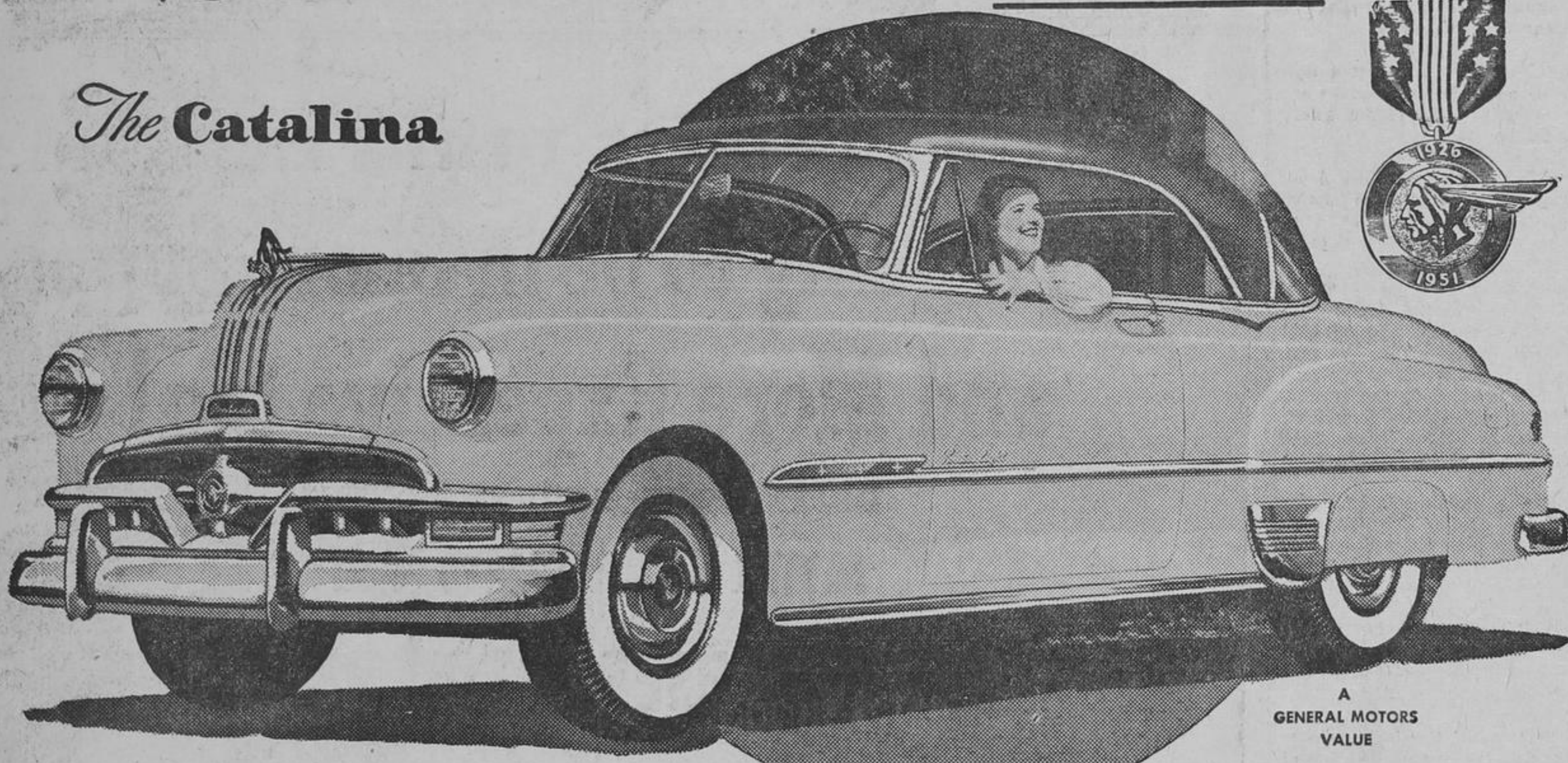

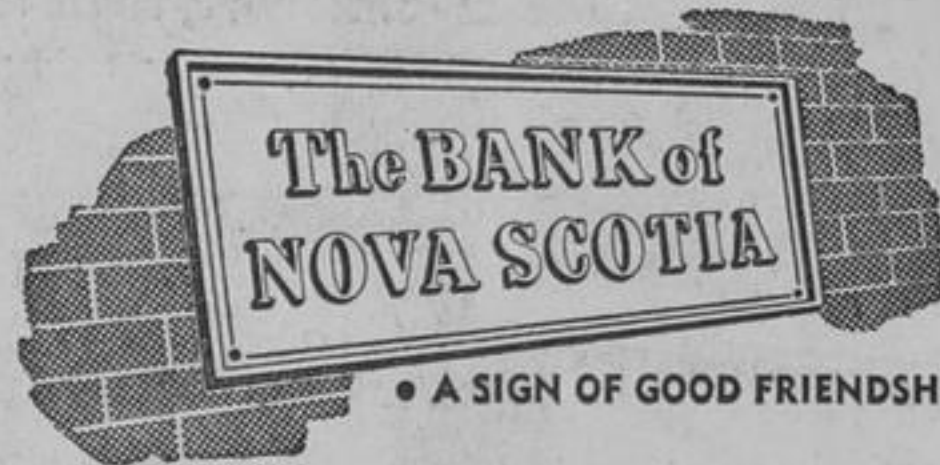

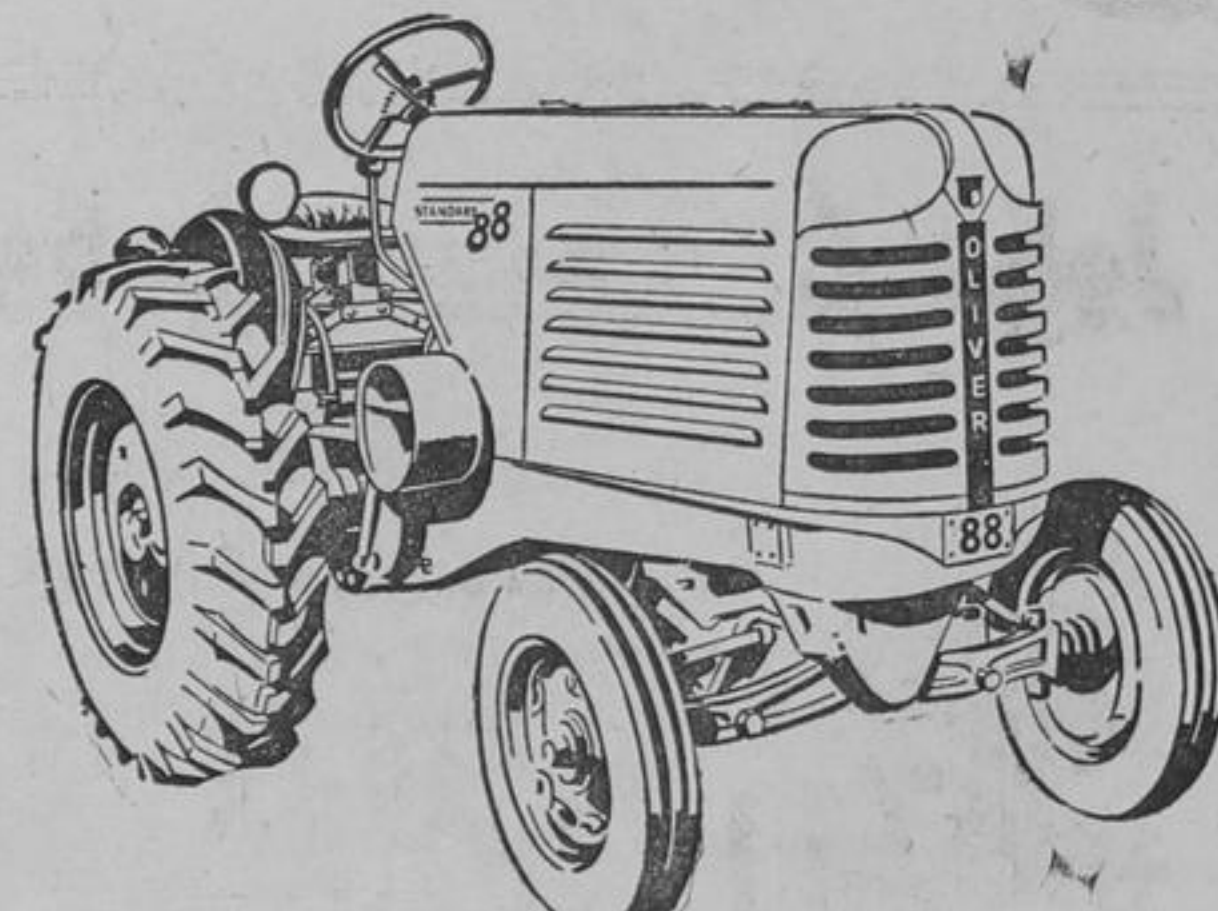
