## Here, There And Everywhere

Creel Census Cards turned in at Prince Albert National Park in 1950 reveal that pike, pickerel and lake trout in that order, were the most important game fish caught in the park. Ranging in length from 10 to 42 inches, a total of 8,720 pike were reported taken, followed by 1,076 pickerel from 8 to 36 inches, and 390 lake trout from 10 to 38 inches.

Commemorating the conference held in 1943 and 1944 between Prime Minister Churchill and President Roosevelt, two tablets on stone masonry pillars were erected opposite the entrance to the inner citadel at Quebec city, in 1950, by the National Parks and Historic Sites Division of the Department of Resources and Development.

Studies of fish and other aquatic life in the lakes and streams of Canada's National Parks insure better catches and better angling regulations for the Park's visitors.

The Yellowknife River Valley area, Northwest Territories, continues to play an important part in Canada's gold and silver production. Milling on an average of 900 tons a day the producing mines recovered 200,663 fine ounces of gold and 62,111 ounces of silver in 1950.

Larger than either Lake Ontario or Lake Erie, Great Slave Lake in Canada's Northwest Territories ranks fifth among the great lakes of the continent. It is about 500 miles long and in places is up to 100 miles wide.

Nearly 11,000 enthusiastic anglers reported on the taking of more than 34,000 fish in Canada's National Parks in 1950. The voluntary creel census conducted by the Canadian Wildlife Service over the past ten years in Canada's National Parks, aids its Limnologists in determining policies in fish stocking and angling regulations for these areas.

## Big Builder

What is a community builder? Often when we use that term we think of the men and women in the town of means and resources who live in fine homes and who own and operate large business enterprises, whose name lends prestige to the town; we think of the men who serve on the Council and the other various public offices; we think of those who belong to the Chamber of Commerce and the various service organizations.

It is quite true that these may be community builders, but we often overlook the men and women of small means who live in unpretentious homes, who have reared and educated a family of boys and girls in the town and have spent their income with the local merchants and the local institutions.

He may not have a great deal to spend, but if his pay cheque is turned back into local business channels to pay other men and keep the wheels of business turning, he is a real community builder.

Such a man is worth a dozen others who, with much greater resources, send it out of the community and away from home.

While he does not get the credit or the name as a community builder, he is worthy as such, and often in his loyalty to home institutions is more helpful as a town builder than many of those of larger means.

Our value as a community builder is not determined so much by what one has in the community, as it is by what one does for the community.
