Increased Telephone Rates For The Area

Increases of 25 cents per month for two-party residence telephone service in Richmond Hill and of 50 cents for residence individual lines are proposed in Bell Telephone's application for revised rates filed in Ottawa with the Board of Transport Commissioners for Canada, according to C. E. Blodale, the company's manager here.

The proposed increase for individual line business service is \$1.25 monthly and for two-party business service it is 75c monthly. No change is proposed in long distance rates.
