At a contest played at the close of the meeting, the prize was awarded to the hostess. The prize was presented by Mrs. H. Follitt, and it was a box of caramels that she had brought from the CNE. The business discussed was as follows:  
 Mrs. John Norris is the convenor of the Food Forum that will be held under the direction of Miss Marion Wight at 8 u.m. on September 24, in the United Church, King City.  
 Mrs. J. Rock was appointed delegate to attend the three day convention of W. I.'s to be held in Toronto at the Royal York, in November.  
 The King ladies were invited to the Gormley W.I. on October 24. They were asked to provide the program for that meeting. The members were invited to Aurora on October 19, to attend a meeting when the topic will be "We call it human nature."  
 The president, Mrs. A. E. Jarvis asked that the ladies listen to the CBC program on Tuesday evenings at 8 o'clock, entitled "In search of ourselves."  
 There was a discussion regarding sending a gift to the W.I. of Cleo, St. Margaret's Shropshire, England, as a remembrance from Canada. Mrs. Pierce, who brought a tea cloth from that Institute in June, will be returning to England soon. It was decided to send a gift valued at \$10.44 back with her. It was thought that an aluminum tea tray might be a typically Canadian souvenir, that would be useful at tea time.  
 The District Annual will be held in King, in June.  
 Two substantial cheques were presented. One, for \$75.00, was presented by Mrs. H. Follitt, as the result of a team from King winning a second prize in a competition at the CNE.
