### King Twp. Holds County Hosp. Bill

Under existing rates all patients are a charge on the hospital, it was decided, when council of King Township was presented with a bill for \$3,505.19 from York Memorial Hospital, Newmarket, to cover the approximate total loss from all the patients from King town-

ship during 1951. It is estimated that on each private patient, there is a loss to the hospital for each day, of \$1.60. For each public ward patient there is a daily loss of \$1.85. It costs \$6.22 to care for each indigent, above the daily grant given by the

government. As the request for \$3,505.19 from O. C. Smith, consulting accountant of Ontario Hospitals Association, was not made until after the tax rate for this year had been set, council was not ready to answer it immediately. It was decided on Monday afternoon at the regular meeting of the councillors that the bill for this sum be tabled for a month, to give the council time to consider it.
