## HOUSES WANTED

SOME OF THE EARLY HISTORY OF LANGSTAFF  
 Langstaff is so called after the family by that name, and its history includes the stories of John Langstaff and his son, John. Another son, James, trained for a doctor and started to practice on Yonge Street North in 1849. James' son, Dr. Ralph Langstaff and grandson, Dr. James Langstaff have succeeded him in the same location and in the original house in Richmond Hill.  
 Yonge Street was first surveyed in 1796 and was marked at each mile by a special tree which was then known as "1 mile tree" or "10 mile tree". "13 mile tree" still stands on the north brow of Thornhill hill at the entrance to the Heintzman Farm. The land on both sides of Yonge Street was divided into 200 acre lots which were granted to settlers on condition that they build a dwelling 16 ft. x 20 ft. of logs or frame with a single roof and occupy it inside of a year, that they clear fit for cultivation and fence 10 acres and that they cut down all the timber in front of and the whole width of the lot for 35 feet in depth, half of which was to be left for the public road.  
 Langstaff had the first school on Yonge Street. It was opened in 1810 by John Langstaff who had come to Canada from New Jersey and had married Lucy Miles, daughter of Abner Miles, who had taken the lot where the Ontario Hospital now is. The school was held in a settlement house built of round logs and was situated on Balsar Munshaw's lot, where Hick's Store now stands. At that time tuition was paid for by the parents and not from taxes. In 1815 the original part of the present Langstaff Public School was built and was used by several religious groups as a church, the land being that of Nicholas Cober. Balsar Munshaw started out from Pennsylvania in 1792 in a covered wagon; incidentally one of the original covered wagons is at Concord, Abner Miles, John Langstaff's father-in-law, had a combination hotel and store; he operated the first express company in Canada, owned vessels on the Lake and was the first contractor and lumber merchant.  
 As Yonge Street was a road of great military importance between York and Penetanguishene, it had to be put in a passable condition. With the government's assistance and the expenditure of £8,000 by the North-West Trading Company, it was lifted out of its footpath status but long maintained its muddy character. A corduroy road reached from Elgin Mills to Richmond Hill and south of it through what was marked as Black Ash Swamp on the earliest map, and to the toll-gate which was erected just south of Langstaff Corner about 1840. The road was macadamized as far as Richmond Hill in the early 1850's. A four-horse coach operated from Richmond Hill to Toronto and was driven by the father-in-law of Mrs. Robert
