The Milne home on Regent St. was searched four different times during the anxious hours but there was no sign of the little girl. Finally her mother said to look there just once more. Her father found her fast asleep on her cousin Debbie's bed, with a big doll lying beside her.

Even strangers joined in the search with neighbours and police and Mr. and Mrs. Babineau said, "We are very grateful for the wonderful help they gave."
