To get that beautiful golden tan, there is a much easier though longer way of doing it — from early in summer, try getting a little sun-tanning each day that the sun shines, starting with a ten-minute period and gradually increasing by ten or fifteen minutes each day. This will help the skin to endure the much longer and stronger sunning out in the open. Take sun-tan lotion on vacation — it helps to prevent burn. As for poison ivy, the best security against that pest is to learn to know it and then avoid it. If there is any contact with it, wash the skin as quickly as possible with strong household soap.
