15 River Valley Authorities Conserve Ontario's Resources

The Home Plowing Competition has a long and honoured tradition in York County and all winners are to be congratulated. It is sponsored by the York Junior Farmers' Association and is under the direction of W. M. Cockburn, Agricultural Representative and E. K. Pearson, Associate Representative of the Ontario Department of Agriculture.

The Authorities are not equipped to carry out extensive investigations which would indicate where such work should be done and the sequence of carrying it out. Consequently, the Conservation Branch of the Department of Planning and Development undertakes such work as a service to the Authorities, and by means of surveys and reports they appraise the conservation need of each watershed and submit a report to the Authority in which the conservation measures necessary to the undertaking are set forth in detail.

When the people of a watershed organize an Authority there are many projects which they may undertake and these may include flood protection, water conservation measures such as small dams and ponds, improvement of summertime recreational assets of the watershed, soil conservation measures, the preservation of historical sites and the improvement of game and fish.

It is most important however, that the people of a river valley be first interested in its natural resources problem and form a Conservation Authority as a corporate body to deal with the problems which the people themselves regard as the most urgent.
