Vacant Farms Cause Of County Weed Problem

Farms which were bought for sub-division purposes and left vacant are becoming more and more a weed menace throughout this county, Weed Inspector Frank Marritt told York County council. He suggested the owners should rent the land to adjacent farmers. "Possibly we should start weed control as soon as these farms are vacant," said Mr. Marritt. "We are forced to wait until they become a menace to surrounding farms before we can make a legal move."

He suggested that rental of the vacant lands to the most simple solution to the problem. The new owner is frequently not a resident of the municipality. Usually he is unaware of weed problems and since it is costing him money to carry the property, he sometimes feels the enforcement of weed control is an added imposition.

"A great deal of this trouble could be avoided if the owner is advised of the problem which will result from neglect of his property," continued Mr. Marritt. "We should start to correct the problem before the weeds become a menace to good agriculture land."

Mr. Marritt told council he had been seeking improvement of the weed act which would make control of weeds on such lands more effective. Provincial authorities have promised to investigate his suggestions, he added.
