They arrive year after year practically on the same day; perhaps it would be more accurate to say the same night. They do migrate at night and appear in waves which are in tune with prevailing weather conditions ;that is, in the warm sector of a low pressure area moving northward. Should a cold front approach, the birds may be stalled for days. Some will stay here, others will push on to the coniferous forests. To give an idea of the warbler population, a count per 100 acres of coniferous stand in Ontario has totalled as high as 319 breeding pairs.
