EMPLOYMENT WANTED

200 Ont. Weekly Editors Conver
Editorial desks all over the province were left empty for two days last week, when 200 members of the Ontario Weekly Editors Association packed their overnight bags and hied themselves to the Royal York Hotel for their annual convention, Friday and Saturday.
And it was time well spent, away from cluttered desks, ringing telephones and the multitude of details which every rural editor faces in his home town newspaper office; for these annual conventions provide a golden opportunity to exchange the latest ideas for keeping readers and advertisers happy — as well as an opportunity to sound off on some untried ideas of one's own. Then there were the lectures and buzz sessions, which were both well attended and lively — and 100 per cent interesting and profitable.
Apart from the pleasure of greeting old friends and making new ones; the thrills that came to some of the members as they were presented with awards for "this" or "that" kind of good job they did with their weekly newspaper in 1958, there was the purely physical enjoyment of dining in lazy luxury and lingering on and on over one's coffee and cigarette — and the speaker coming to you to talk instead of you having to jump into a cold car, and chase off to some draughty hall or overheated school to take notes.
As another highlight the Ontario weekly editors had the distinction of touring the new \$1 million dollar addition to the Royal York — two weeks prior to its formal opening date of February 21.
The new 400-room addition will increase the hotel's capacity to 1,600 rooms, making it the largest in the British Commonwealth. Throughout the strikingly designed public rooms, name and decorated for the province and territories of Canada, to the Canadian Room (185 feet long 75 feet wide) largest of its kind in the country and keystone of the theme, a decorative "Pattern Canada" is created in a score of dramatic forms, including intricate woodwork, glowing bouquets of metallic emblems, such as the Ontario Trillium, make up and abra — every room different, tooled leather hides emblazon with authentic western cat brands, French-Canadian tapestries and provincial and national handicrafts play an expressive part with a fabulously luxurious yet subdued elegance of style.
We just can't get away from the home town influence however, for we especially noted that a floor in the Canada room, which "will outlast the lifetime of the building, instead of having to be replaced (as is our custom) every 10 years," was of Greenwood — the same wood employed in the newest of the Richmond Hill Public Schools at Crosby Heights.
