Barth's Opens Another Plant

Two years ago Mr. Phillip Barth came to Richmond Hill and established a successful dry cleaning and shirt laundering business at 198 Yonge Street North. Last week Mr. Barth secured the lease for 10 years with option to purchase the building of the Aurora Textiles Limited, located at Yonge Street South, in Aurora, with a total floor space of 9,300 square feet.

The Richmond Hill plant of Barth's Cleaners has 2,500 square feet, employing 20 people, but due to the increasing trade with routes in the Aurora area it was necessary to instal a plant in Aurora. Mr. Barth plans on having one route serving Aurora and Oak Ridges, and a second Newmarket and Bradford.

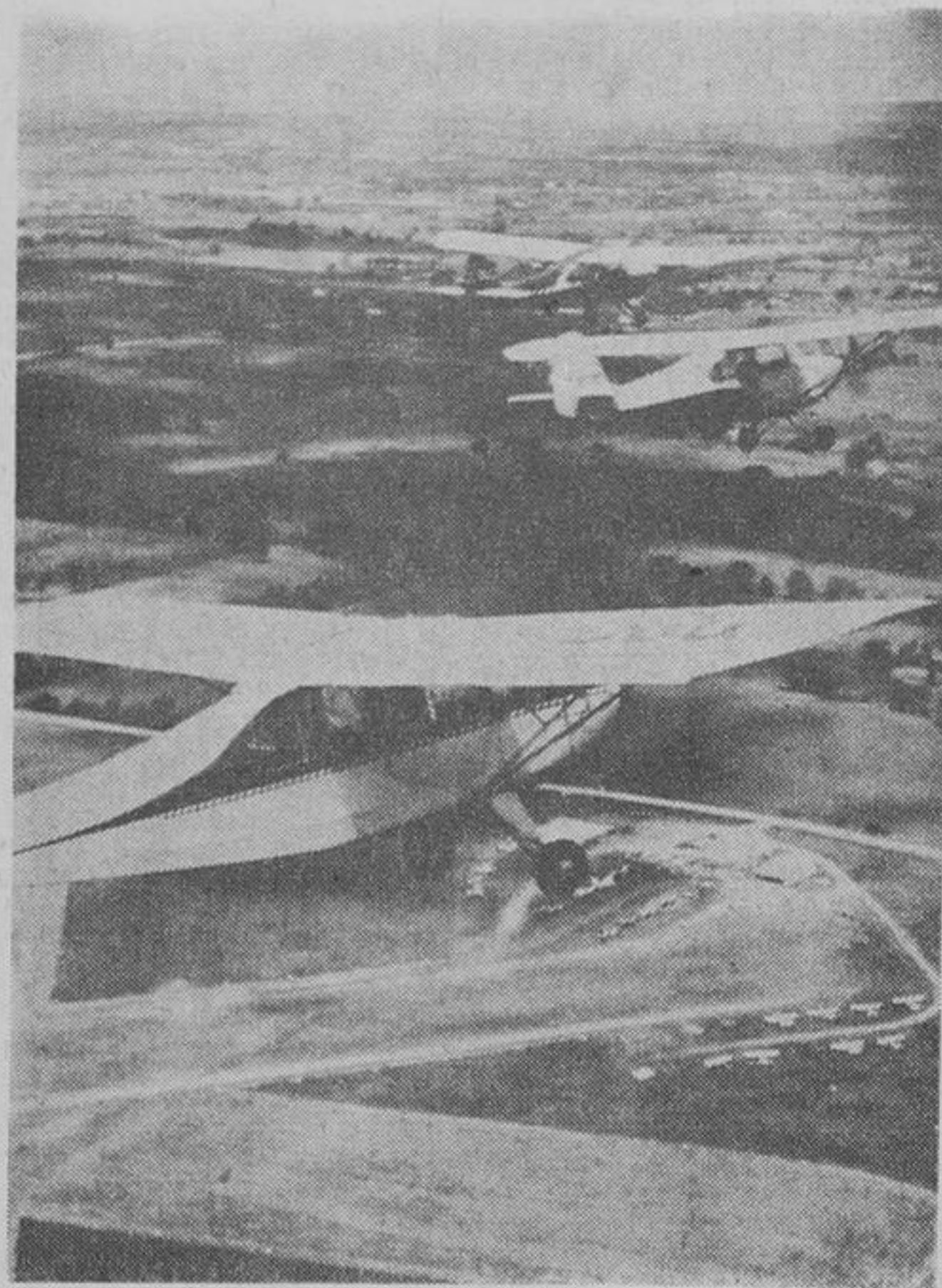
FACT FOR THE WEEK:

Many facets of cancer growth and treatment are being explored in Canada. These projects include: —

Flying Field At Buttonville



When Richmond Hill residents glance aloft as small planes fly overhead — maybe they do not realize that some of our local people are flying enthusiasts — members of the Buttonville Flying Club, and that the owner of the Gillies Flying Service with airport at Buttonville, Mr. J. W. Gerace, lives on Lucas Street, Richmond Hill.

In this local flying club there are many husband-wife and father-son teams — all licensed pilots — enjoying all the thrills of flying their own planes, visiting other flying clubs, with "breakfast dates" in Oshawa, Hamilton, Windsor and other numerous centres with landing fields. Social events are not neglected by the club, and a "Weiner Roast and Dance" is planned for mid-June.

The Buttonville Flying Club at present has an active membership of 100, and 200 students, possessing an enviable record.

During 1958 — 100 students graduated, securing private licenses, 8 commercial licenses, and 6 instructional licenses. President of the club is Mr. Elgin Bird, (owner of Aero-coupe light plane); Treasurer, Mrs. Terry Karch (Aeronca plane); and Secretary, Mr. James Doidge. The club is also fortunate to have available the services of the chief instructional pilot — Mr. J. W. Gerace, a veteran instructor and pilot of 35 years, whose achievements would fill several books. Recent improvements to the airport include: longer, wider, smoother runways, 2-96 feet in length, radio and light control of aircraft traffic, and equipment for night flying. From 50 to 60 aircraft are generally on the field.

The Buttonville Flying Club wish it known that the welcome mat is always out to those interested in this fascinating combination of sport, valuable training, and occupational possibilities.

NOTICE of Closing and Selling A Portion of Palmer Avenue

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Town of Richmond Hill will consider at a meeting at the Municipal Hall at the Town of Richmond Hill, in the County of York on the 22nd day of June, 1959, a by-law to close up and sell a portion of Palmer Avenue, described as follows, namely:

the southerly ten feet (10') of Palmer Avenue lying between the extension of the westerly limit of Conestoga Avenue and the extension of the easterly limit of Sussex Avenue.

The Council shall hear in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent any person who claims that his land will be prejudicially affected by the said by-law and who applies to be heard.
