Community Service Growing

Richmond Hill V.O.N. Held Annual Meeting

The annual meeting of Richmond Hill V. O. N. was held last Thursday evening when encouraging reports were received reflecting the growth and progress of the work in this community. Established here in January 1958 V. O. N. has become a very popular service and there has been high praise for the work of Miss Eileen Woodbyrne and her assistants. Mrs. Jean Thomson charter president of 5% local organization was re-elected to office and in her remarks to the annual meeting extended warm thanks to the people of Richmond Hill for their generous support, to the municipal council for their co-operation and to Miss Woodbyrne and her assistants for dedicated devotion to duty. Other elections were as follows: 1st vice-president; Mrs. J. R. McAlister, 2nd vice-president; J. E. Smith, Committee members, R. D. Little, Dr. Jean O'Neil, Mrs. J. A. Coughlin, W.B. McDougall, Sandy Neal; secretary R. W. Chandler; Treasurer, H. R. Ludlow, Councilor Tom Broadhurst represents the Town Council on the committee. H. R. Ludlow, treasurer presented the detailed financial statement, and R. D. Little gave the report of the nominating committee. Miss Eileen Woodbyrne, nurse here since the inception of the service gave a very interesting report of the activities of the organization.

Work increasing Miss Woodbyrne said "It is good to be able to report to you an increase of 5% in number of visits made in 1959, and an increase of 19% in number of individuals served. This increase can be attributed partly to the initiative and enthusiasm of the Board of Management in making our service known to families and community groups and particularly to growing needs in a growing town. There are 15,032 men, women and children here in Richmond Hill. Just 270 of these are over 69 years of age. Thirty-four from this senior group received 532 visits from V. O. N. In other words this tiny segment of the population accounts for 33% of all visits. This then is the V. O. N. story on a national scale as well as our own local scene. It is the seniors who fall heir to chronic disabling diseases which require more concentrated care over a longer period of time. It is the seniors who have so much to offer to society intellectually, culturally as well as economically. Dr. F. B. Roth, Deputy Minister of Health for Saskatchewan, in an article in Canadian Journal Public Health has this to say, "Patients with long term illness can deteriorate at a truly remarkable rate and this deterioration is not explainable solely on medical grounds. Rather it is a process of emotional and psychological stagnation." Furthermore Dr. Roth goes on to say, and this brings problem right to us, "Since long term patients can be cared for in their own homes, and I would suspect prefer to be cared for there - provision should be made for a wide variety of services required to meet needs of patients in their homes." Their basic need is nursing care and health counselling and this is the primary aim of V. O. N. The nurse will visit daily or less often according to needs, and always under supervision of a doctor. The greater percentage of V. O. N. time is spent with patients who fall into this category. Community organizations are aware of and are working towards provision of this second need. Our care to senior people is not the whole story of V. O. N. Service is available to every age group, regardless of race or religion. Mothers and babies are the largest segment in our population analysis and V. O. N. had
