**No Change In H. School Budget**  
 (Continued from page 1)  
 A former public school trustee suggested that any criticism of the salary schedule should be directed to the provincial government and not the local board. "The figure of \$9,000 is the maximum and it certainly wouldn't apply to the majority of our staff," contended Trustee Wood.

In reply to questions from Mayor Tomlin, Trustee Wood stated there has been no appreciable increase in the number of students finishing grade 13. Only 13% of those who enroll in grade 9 ever remain to complete grade 13.

**Vocational School**  
 Chairman Rumble stated the board is investigating the possibility of establishing limited vocational school. At present, industrial arts are being taught in all the schools and any pupil who so wishes can on completion of grade 9 enroll in a vocational course in the Toronto schools. The cost of such a course is borne by the district board. Last year the board paid out \$12,000 to other boards in fees.

As a means of making greater use of the school buildings Councilor T. Broadhurst wondered if the board had taken any action on a suggestion of former Chairman Harry Sayers that the school day and year be lengthened. Mr. Rumble stated that any changes in this respect would have to come from the Department of Education.
