\$120,000. Contract Is
Awarded To Vaughan

At its October 31 meeting, Vaughan Township Council awarded a \$120,000.00 contract, deal with the Langstaff interchange question and with road responsibility in Thornhill and a small subdivision north of Elgin Mills Sideroad.
Contract
K. J. Beamish Construction Company Thornlea, has been awarded a \$120,000.00 contract. (Subject to a few changes for some five miles of roads of base preparation on Bathurst Street and Concession 7. The township has decided to do its own brushing and grubbing on the two travel lanes. The amount involved is about \$2,500, most of which would be recovered under the winter works program. Vaughan now is checking to see if the two items can be brought in as winter works projects.
Bathurst Street
The two and one-half miles of road work on Bathurst and linking up with the new Thornhill by-pass being created by the highways department. The intention is to leave the majority of this, and the Concession 7 paving until spring subsequent to the construction of the base as awarded to K. J. Beamish. Bathurst provides the people living within the Yonge Street-Bathurst area with an alternative to going down Yonge Street.
Concession 7 runs up to the Pine Valley Golf Course and the interchange park.
The Langstaff interchange involves a by-pass to the north of Thornhill which will run north on Bathurst Street from No. 7 Highway to the Langstaff Road and turn east across Yonge and join up with No. 7 on the east side of Yonge. This project will ultimately become reality. Within the area where the interchange is to be re-located and where the entrance of the re-located Langstaff Road comes out on Yonge Street, the township must re-locate the water mains. The Department of Highways have agreed to put up approximately \$30,000 while Vaughan will issue debentures to cover the balance of money needed, estimated at \$20,000. The debentures will become a charge-back to the water area.
Council agreed to go ahead and apply to the Ontario Municipal Board for approval of the debenture issue. The board will hold a hearing in due course.
Park Land
In this area the township owns a five and one-acre park. To facilitate the interchange, the Property Branch of the Department of Highways wants to buy about one and three-quarter acres of this land, but the cash offer has not met with enthusiasm on part of the council. Vaughan's administrators want the department to buy the entire park, then the township, with the money received, will look elsewhere for another park. Negotiations are continuing but all the evidence points up to a lengthy bargaining session between the department and the township.
