**Richmond Hill Parking Authority Makes Start Solving Yonge Problem**

The Richmond Hill Parking Authority was formed by By-Law late in September of 1960. Since its inauguration the authority has held a number of meetings and several proposals have been, and are presently under consideration.

The authority is comprised of 3 members. Al Harley, a well known and energetic citizen being chairman together with Stu Coxford and Don Plaxton as the other two members. While the authority has jurisdiction over municipal parking over the entire municipality, of necessity the work has been concentrated in the main commercial area of the town on Yonge Street.

The immediate problem confronting the authority is to provide parking facilities to merchants and businessmen who find themselves in an increasingly competitive position with the newer and larger Parking Plazas. The Authority welcomes the addition of our newest stores and businesses and will no doubt in the future have to deal with parking problems which may arise in these areas, but the basic problem remains that of alleviating the down town parking situation. It is increasingly evident that their problem is not a simple one - acquiring the necessary land and money is today the main problem. To date the authority has accomplished the following:

- (1) Graded and gravelled the Town property on the north side of Lorne Avenue for municipal parking.
- (2) Entered into a rental agreement with Principal Investments

Ltd., for the acquisition on a temporary basis of their property on the east side of Yonge St., just north of the Bank of Nova Scotia.

(3) Obtained a report on the cost of grading and graveling the area on the west side of Yonge St. North of the Post Office on Arnold St. This will be considered in the year 1961, after evaluating the success of the Parking lot on the east side of Yonge St.

(4) Recommended that the no parking ban on Yonge St. be rejected by the Council.

(5) Placed orders for Parking signs for the above properties.

(6) Adopted on an interim basis the removal of parking meters on the Richmond St. lot and incorporated on this and the Principal Investment lot the intention of renting up to 1/4 the space on a monthly basis.

(7) Discussed and agreed upon the budget to present to the 1961 council.

It is of course true to say that much of this work is only a step in the right direction. Basically the authority does not have funds available until 1961 but has incurred expenses in 1960 which are included in the budget proposed.

**Authority Members**  
We can say that they are very much aware of the problem of lack in parking facilities with the resultant decrease in assessment and are anxious to bring to the public attention the fact that parking is "Everybody's business." A report is presently being prepared for presentation to Council.

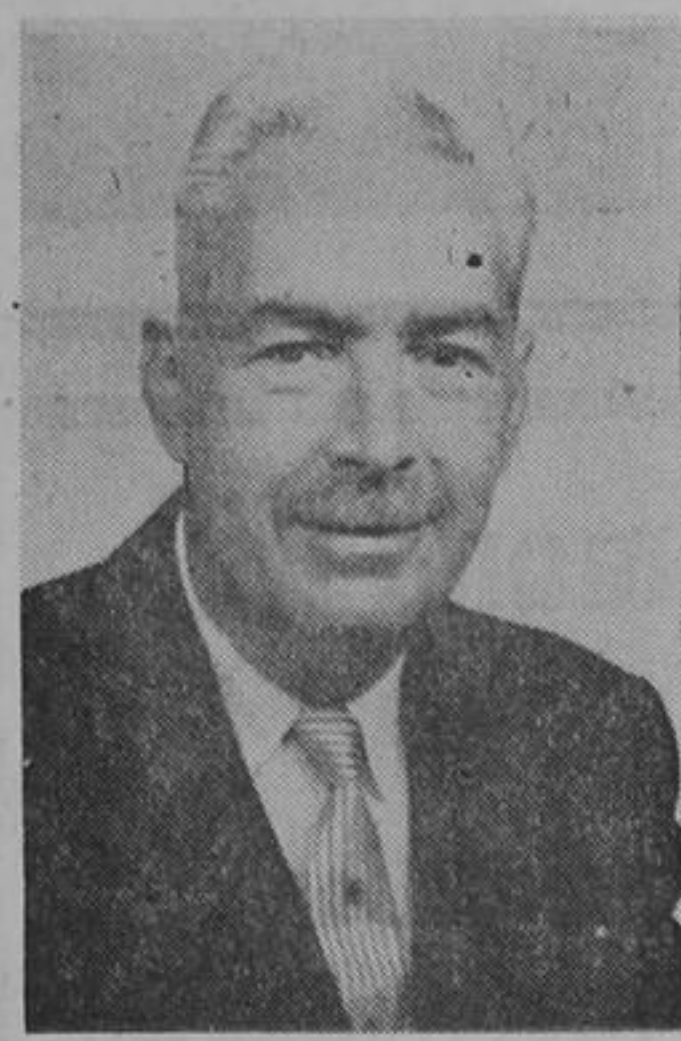

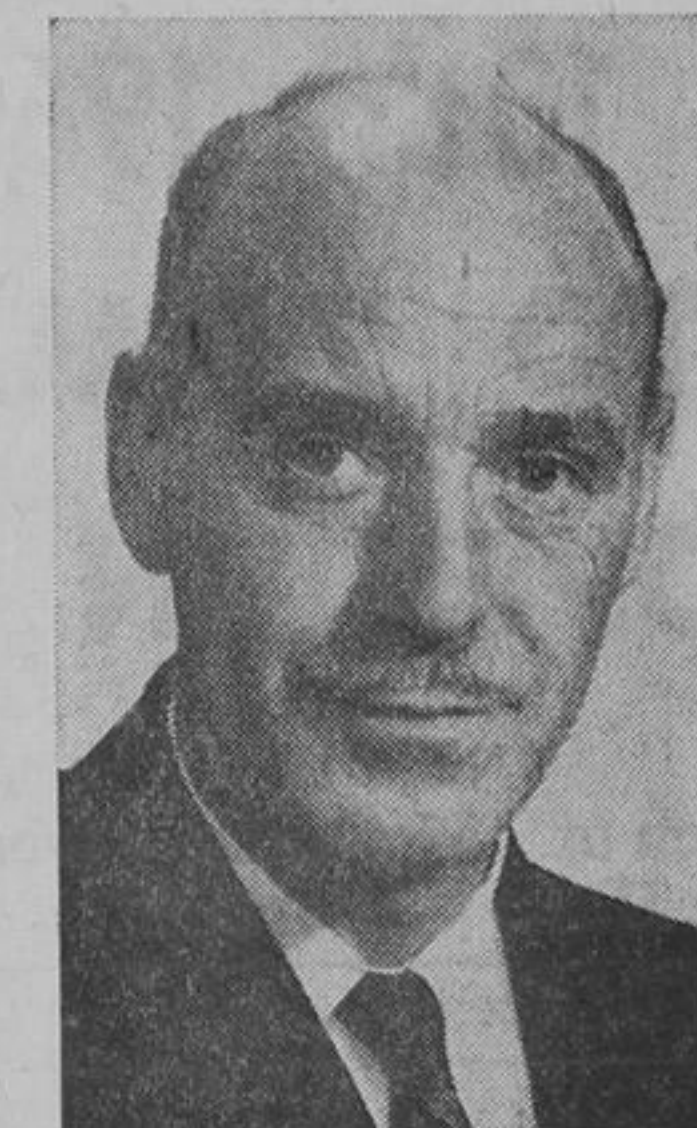

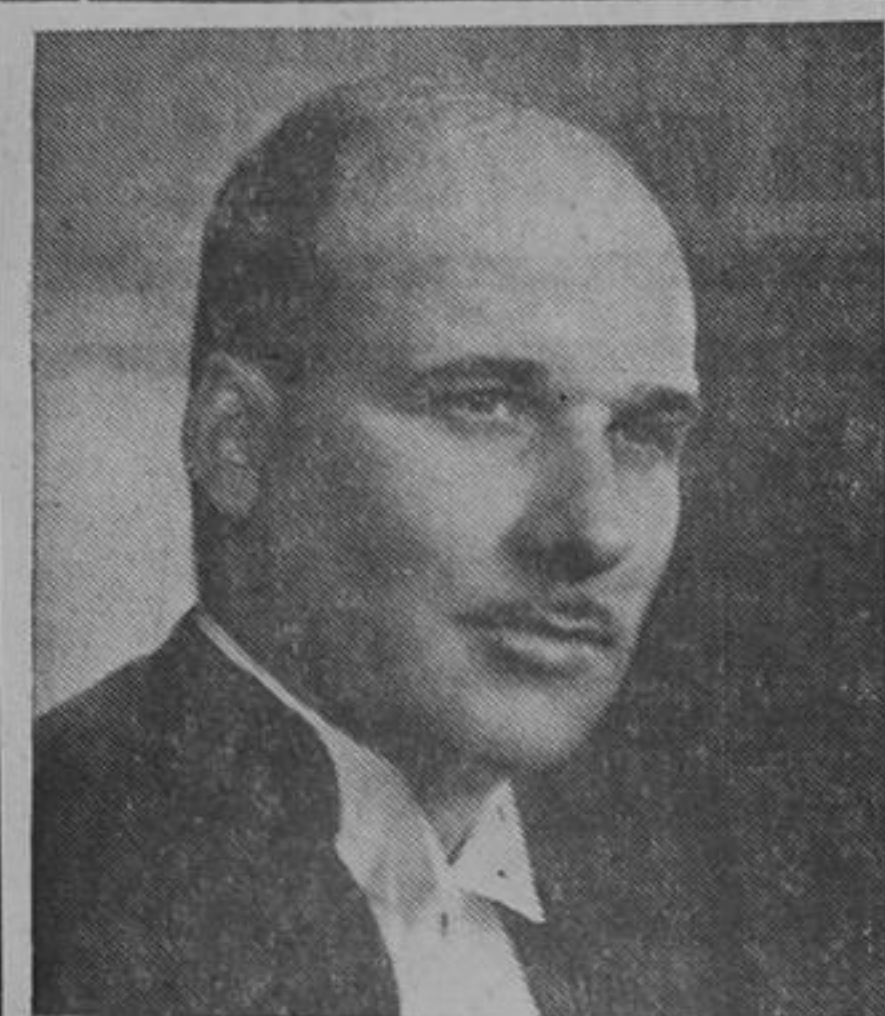
