Vaughan Township's total road mileage is 277.2 of which the township is fully responsible for 179.4 miles. This figure represents a 2.2 mile increase during 1960, relative to the registered plans' residential lots. Altogether there were 524 lots in the different plans, including 250 in the Lomax Subdivision on Elgin Mill's sideroad. When these lots are developed the township will assume another mile or two of roads.
