To the names of those lending their hands and talents to the village of Thornhill should be added that of Mrs. W. Harold Clark of 16 Elgin Street, Thornhill, who is president of the Indian-Eskimo Association of Canada. This organization, which received its national charter in December, 1959, was the outgrowth of the National Commission on the Indian Canadian. This in turn started in 1957 as a study committee of about 20 persons, chaired by Mrs. Clark.
