OF NORTH YORK Hazards for Toddlers Some safety precautions for toddlers are to make sure your children's toys, playground furniture and playpens are inspected regularly so that any damage to them will not leave splinters or sharp edges where they could injure the youngster. It's a good idea too to buy only toys that can be washed at high temperatures since most youngsters have a hand-to-mouth existence and this is the only effective way of keeping toys germ-free. If you use mothballs, which are highly poisonous, put them in a perforated canister, so your child won't be tempted to swallow them. Cover all unused light sockets. Up From Year Ago Vaughan Township's 1961 welfare budget of \$40,000 will fall considerably short of requirements if the second six-month relief outlay matches the \$27,566 already spent since January 1. Pointing up this strong possibility are two facts; this July 147 person received assistance totalling \$3,049, compared to 63 persons and \$1,337 for July, 1960. The January-July, 1961, bill of \$27,566 compares to \$11,503 for the same period in 1960. Eighty per cent of welfare assistance payments comes back to the township in the form of federal and provincial grants.

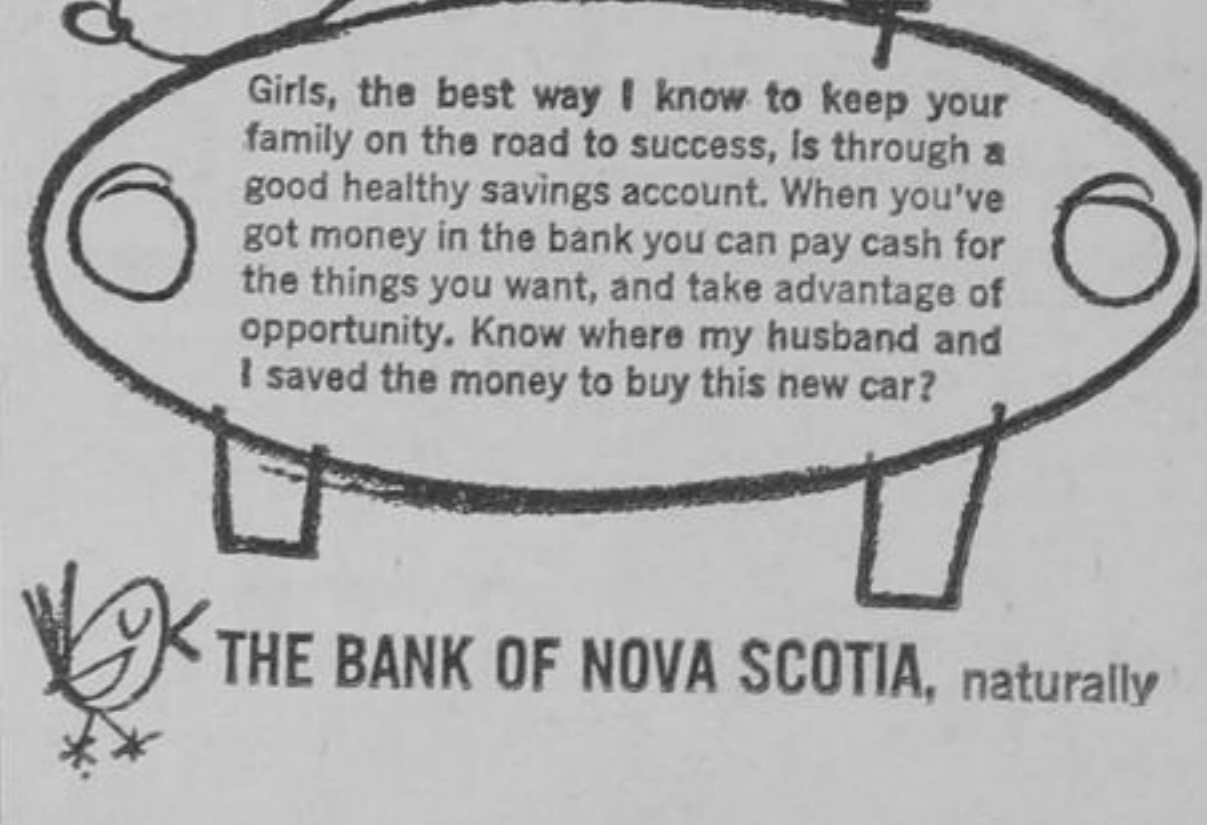
