Various reports were read and the program for the coming year was outlined briefly. Members were urged to attend the regional meeting on September 28th since it is to be held at St. Luke's this year.

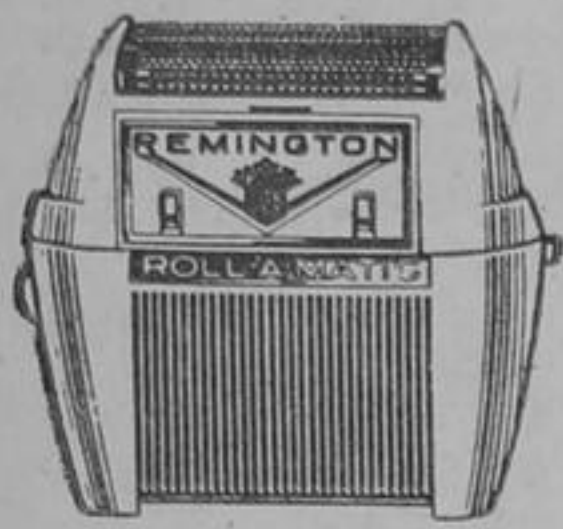
Refugee Family
