Junior Auxiliary Also Formed

Name Hospital Auxiliary Officers At Big Turn-out Of Area's Ladies

Another step towards the operation of York Central Hospital, scheduled for an early start of construction on Vaughan Road, was made last week when, after a highly successful organizational meeting several weeks ago, approximately two hundred ladies met in the auditorium of Richmond Hill United Church to elect officers and arrange other organizational details. Those present represented a wide area in southern York County.

A nominating committee headed by Mrs. F. C. Snively of Oak Ridges presented a slate which was accepted by acclamation. President of the new auxiliary is Mrs. R. J. Miller, with Mrs. Ernest Redeimer as first vice-president and membership convener, Mrs. H. R. Howden is second vice-president and constitution convener, Mrs. W. A. Smith was named recording secretary and Mrs. W. C. Wilson corresponding secretary.

Treasurer is Mrs. W. Kedwell and public relations convener is Mrs. G. A. Walter. Mrs. Fred Leaf was named press convener. The chairman of the junior auxiliary who draws membership from high schools, is Miss Ruth Kinsella. Two men will be appointed to the executive as members-at-large, while the two lady members are Mrs. Langdon and Mrs. S. Parker. It represented proceeds of an open house and hair-styling demonstration held at Chez Pauline by Mrs. P. Braey-Gibbon as a fund-raising project. York Central Hospital Chairman Douglas Storms said that it was expected that the first sod would be turned in April. Tenders would be called around the end of March. Emphasizing the great need for the hospital, he said that it would be inadequate before it was finished. The first phase was being proceeded with and the building was being planned so that the second stage could be developed with the least possible amount of trouble.

The Sunday School room was decorated in Valentine style for the United Church Women's luncheon February 28. This luncheon was provided by Mrs. L. Hart and her helpers, Mrs. C. Walker, Mrs. C. Story, Mrs. K. Petty, Mrs. J. Leitch and Mrs. R. Frisby. There were 44 ladies, one gentleman, and 10 children present. Following the luncheon, the meeting of the United Church Women was held. Mrs. C. Mrs. H. McCague thanked the anonymous donor of the minute-book and the treasurer's book. A cash donation from a former member, Miss A. Fierheller, a cash balance from the W.M.S. Literature Fund, and a W.A. and W.M.S. donation for supplies was given. Youths Forget Where They Were
Offences So Numerous Guilt Pleas Overdone
Two members of a local "break and enter" gang which has been in operation in the area for almost two years appeared in the Magistrate's Court last Thursday on a total of more than 35 charges of break and entry. A third man, who is also thought to be a member of the gang, was remanded until March 15.

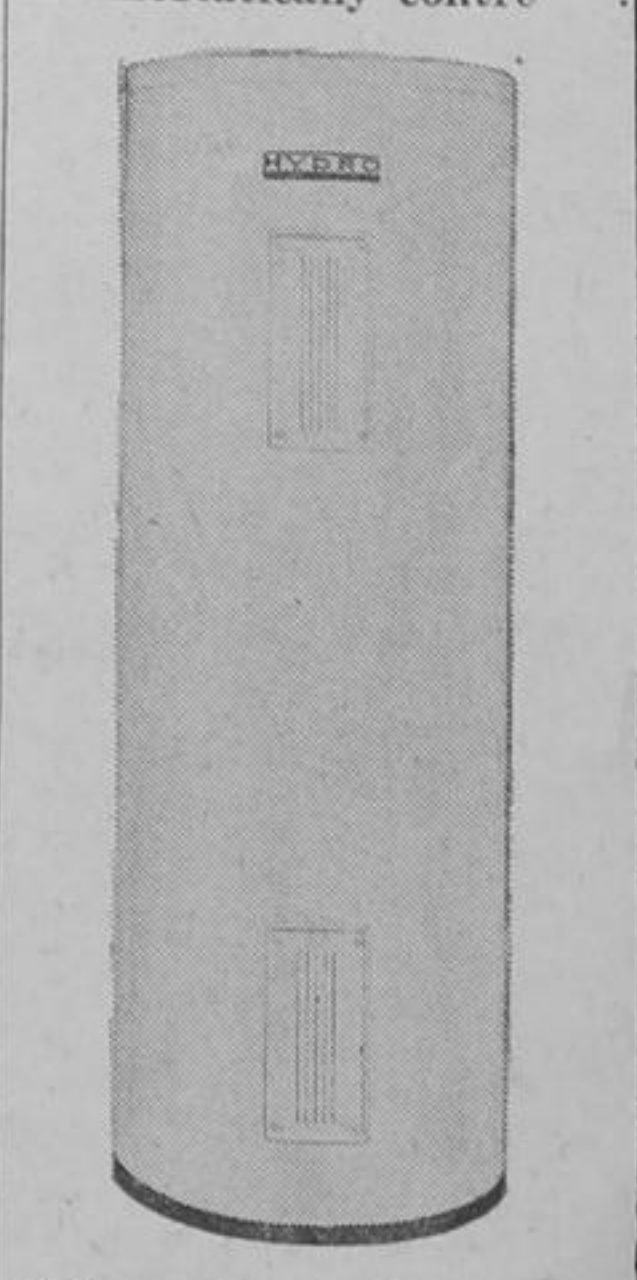
Garry Smith and Allen Hartford, both of Richvale, pleaded guilty on all charges. The offences were committed in Vaughan, Whitchurch and Markham Townships as well as Richmond Hill, Metro Toronto and Woodbridge.

Eight of the break-ins occurred in Richmond Hill, two each in Markham Township and Metro Toronto and one in Woodbridge. Total loot from the break-ins is thought to be more than \$1,800, of which nothing has been recovered. The first offence occurred in June or July of 1960 and since that time the youths have done so many "jobs" that they had even lost track of them themselves. They even pleaded guilty to one charge that was laid against them on an offence committed during 1959 - almost a year before they began their operations. This was dismissed.

\$1,347,000 Offer Turned Down
Toronto Will Discuss Jail Farm With Markham Township Officials
As expected, Toronto's Board of Control turned down the offer of \$1,347,000 for the Jail Farm property at Langstaff, made to it two weeks ago. After calling for tenders and receiving only one offer, the board referred it to its real estate director, David Alexander, who recommended that it not be accepted. The bid was much lower than expected by the Board of Control, which had anticipated receiving a considerable sum which would help to pay for the underground parking lot.
