 February 20th, 1962, was "Orbit Day" for Astronaut Lt.-Col. John Glenn. And on the same date a Richmond Hill family pretty nearly went into orbit too as one bit of good news succeeded another. The family as a whole is pictured above. It's that of the Turtons of 160 Church Street South. There's a story out of the ordinary behind the picture, too.

It was taken two years ago by the federal Department of Immigration. The Turtons - at least those of them who had made their appearance on earth up to that time - came to Canada in 1947. Seeking for a British family which had made a worthwhile adjustment to Canadian life, the department chose the Turtons. Their picture was used in connection with a publicity release which told of the success of such families in Canada.
