The above appointment is for the hearing of an application made by The Ontario Water Resources Commission on behalf of the Corporation of the Township of Markham for approval of an agreement with the Commission for the construction by the Commission of a storm sewer system at an estimated cost of \$360,000 and for the repayment of the same over a period of thirty years.

After allowing an estimated grant of \$75,000 from the Department of Highways, the estimated annual cost of the storm sewer project is \$26,087, which includes interest, debt retirement, operating cost and reserve for renewals, replacements and contingencies.
