The sale of Elorn Farm, on Maple Road near Highway 400, ends a four-generation-long occupation of the place by McKinnons, the first having taken over the farm in 1842. At that time the latest owner's great-grandfather bought the farm from three sisters of a Richmond Hill resident, James Miles,

who willed it to the women. The original owner was a John MacDonald who, it is thought, got the farm, which originally covered 200 acres, on a Crown grant in 1799. Mr. MacDonald sold the farm to the aforementioned Mr. Miles in 1812 and Miles subsequently willed it to his sisters, who sold it to the first McKinnon resident in 1842.

The farm, which covers only 90 acres now, was used primarily for mixed farming originally, but for the last 20 years McKinnons have been raising dairy herds on the place.

After the new owners, Findlay Dairy of Toronto, takes over, Mr. McKinnon will move to Richmond Hill.

FACT FOR THE WEEK:  
A major advance in attempts to cure cancer with chemistry was achieved by Canadian research workers who discovered in the periwinkle plant an ingredient called vinaleukoblastine, or VLB. The discovery was made while trying unsuccessfully to verify a Jamaican folk-lore belief that tea made with the leaves of the plant was effective against diabetes. VLB has been found effective in delaying the advance of certain kinds of cancer. It is still under investigation.
