The plan, Mr. Forrest stated, further changes would mean a delay of three or four months, he stated.

When discussion of the by-law itself came up, Reeve Wilfred Dean suggested council should pass it and let any objections go to the Ontario Municipal Board instead of holding it up.

"It seems too bad to send these objectors down to perfect councilor Charles Hooper."

"Any further reconsideration would mean further changes and another hold-up," charged Councillor Allan Sumner.

Mr. Hooper suggested that a special meeting of planning board should be called to discuss the three objections. "If the planning board can prove the validity of its plan, there needn't be any delay," Council declined to call the meeting.

Councillor Hoover, who voted against the bylaw, said that the objector could go to the O.M.B. "This plan isn't final. It can be reviewed at a later date," Reeve Wilfred Dean said.
