A resident here for five years, Mr. George, 35, is a draftsman.
"I've talked about running for the past three years," he told "The Liberal" this week, "and when I heard there was a vacancy on the board I decided it was time to stop talking and do something."
Employed on the administrative staff of the University of Toronto, Mr. Nesbitt, 43, has had wide experience working with the province's secondary schools.
Mr. Nesbitt said his position kept him busy in the summer months but left him plenty of free time to devote to board affairs during the school season.
Making his first bid for public office Mr. Stephenson, 32, is a building contractor with offices in Richmond Hill and Willowdale.
He feels his experience in school construction will be of value to the board if he is successful.
"With more schools being planned I feel I have experi-

ences in this line that would benefit the taxpayers," the candidate said.
Although he realizes that his firm would be ineligible to bid on school construction if he is a trustee, Mr. Stephenson said he was willing to make this sacrifice if his knowledge could be put to use.
He is married and has three children, all attending MacKillop School.
One poll will be open at the municipal hall between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.
