Lounges, Beer Parlours

Out By Wide Margin

East Gwillimbury Township voters last week voted against all four liquor and beer questions on a special plebiscite.

Only dining lounges and cocktail lounges came close to being approved. The vote was 1,457 to 1,353 against dining lounges and 1,516 to 1,282 against cocktail lounges.

Men's beverage rooms were defeated 2,064 to 659 and mixed beverage rooms 1,889 to 888. It was the first liquor vote in the township.

In The Matter of By-law No. 1000, as amended And In The Matter of Premises known as 198 Yonge St. N., Richmond Hill, Part Block B, Reg'd Plan 5151.

And In The Matter Of an application by Phillip Barth, owner of the said property for permission to build an addition of 350 square feet to the north-east corner of the present building. The front wall of the addition would be 12 feet 3/4 inch from the street line and the existing building and addition would cover 2750 square feet of a lot, whereas, By-law 1000 as amended allows a building in a Commercial C 2 Zone to cover not more than 40% of the lot (in this case 40% of 6200 square feet equals 2480 square feet lot coverage) and a minimum front yard of 17 feet.

The Committee of Adjustment has appointed Wednesday, January 2, 1963, at 7:45 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Buildings for the purpose of a Public Hearing in this matter.
