## Public Interest High

Public interest and participation in a number of conservation and outdoor activities has again been much in evidence during 1962.

Tree planting, creel census and hunting information from sportsmen, recreational use in provincial parks and forest fire prevention efforts, are some of the areas where interest continues to be demonstrated.

Co-operation in this way, by both individuals and organized groups, is of considerable assistance to Department of Lands and Forests staff and makes a definite contribution in the resources management program, department officials say.

### Will House Clinic

In New Addition  
When Completed

North York's first mental health clinic is to be opened soon at Branson Hospital as part of the new hospital addition.

The clinic could be put in operation in temporary quarters before the new building is finished.

A. George Roberts, hospital administrator, says plans so far are in a state of "suspended animation" because the psychiatrist they hope to get to head up the clinic has not yet given a firm acceptance of their offer.

The proposed clinic would employ a psychiatrist, a clinical psychologist and a social worker and would be equipped to handle out-patients.

About 20 beds are to be made available for psychiatric patients in the new 427 bed extension of the hospital.

Plans for the hospital addition are completed and Dr. Erwin Crawford, chief of staff, says tenders "could be let tomorrow." Officials are waiting to find out how much money the hospital levy approved in the recent North York Township election will bring.

Mr. Rodgers says that if a decent sized house could be found to rent the clinic might operate off the hospital grounds temporarily.

Support for the plan comes from the Canadian Mental Health Association, Ontario Hospital Services Commission and the North York Hospital Council.
