# Local Groups Win Many Awards

"A tremendous success" was the overwhelming consensus of opinion of both exhibitors and the general public when viewing the annual York Summit Boy Scout Handicraft and Hobby Show at the Richmond Hill United Church February 23.

The 5th Richmond Hill winners of the George Harvey Memorial Trophy awarded to the group accumulating the most points, with the Pack award going to 5th Richmond Hill "A" Pack, and the Troop award to the 5th Richmond Hill Scout Troop.

Points were awarded on a 10-8-5-3 basis for first, second, third and good effort respectively. An additional point was awarded for each entry submitted.

Top Cub packs were 5th Richmond Hill "A" Pack, 344 points; 1st Richmond Hill "B" Pack, 181; 3rd Richmond Hill, 147; 6th Richmond Hill, 139; and 5th Richmond Hill "B" Pack 138 points.

Top Scout Troops were 5th Richmond Hill, 99 points, 6th Richmond Hill, 96, 1st Beverley Acres, 91, 8th Richmond Hill, 85, and 2nd Thornhill, 66 points.

The committee and judges were swamped with the arrival of 1,075 exhibits which surpassed last year's entries by 20 per cent.

Each year the boys gain in enthusiasm and enlarge the scope of their endeavors, and as a result a shortage of display space was encountered necessitating the use of another room.

One of the more unusual incidents of the show was when Gerry Fresque of the 2nd Richmond Hill Cub Pack entered a model railroad structure in the Scout classification of model railroading, and walked off with the first prize ribbon. This same exhibit won a special award donated by Keith Hobby Shop as the best over-all entry by a Cub.
