

A gymnastics display was given in the gym, a film of school highlights in 1962 and 1963 was shown in room 21 French conversations, choirs and recitals were being given in two rooms and Latin recordings were heard in another. Alas, it was impossible to get around to them all - especially when so many were so fascinating that it was difficult to tear away from them.


