Pool Financing A Major Problem

(Continued From Page 1) ility-financed pool, the Alderwood Swimming Pool in Etobicoke was built at a cost of \$222,000 plus architects' fees which made a total of \$235,000. According to Pool Manager John Finch, to duplicate the pool today, the cost would be \$275,000.

The people of Alderwood, the southern community in Etobicoke, raised \$46,000 in an intensive build-the-pool campaign and voted for a one mill tax rate for two years to give a revenue of \$50,000; the township of Etobicoke paid the remainder.

Mr. Finch said the pool there is not too busy and has been operating at an annual deficit of approximately \$26,000. The staff includes one pool supervisor, two swim instructors, one locker room attendant and a part-time cashier. There are also seven part-time employees on call when groups or schools use the pool.

Major objection to a pool, or so it would appear, is the financing through a boost in the tax rate but if this was spread as it was in Alderwood over a period of years, the hike would hardly be felt.

The land is available, according to reliable authorities. With council's plans and backing and a long-range view of the financing and just as important, the maintenance, this community of 18,000 could provide the facilities for its 6,000 or more school children to learn to swim or to enjoy swimming as a major recreation and exercise.

What is needed, in addition to that backing is a strong aggressive campaign committee such as the one which recognized the need and brought about such remarkable results for the construction of York Central Hospital, Mrs. Hancey said.

But no amount of planning will work without 100 per cent support of everyone in the community. This support can be made evident by a strong interested delegation at next week's meeting.
