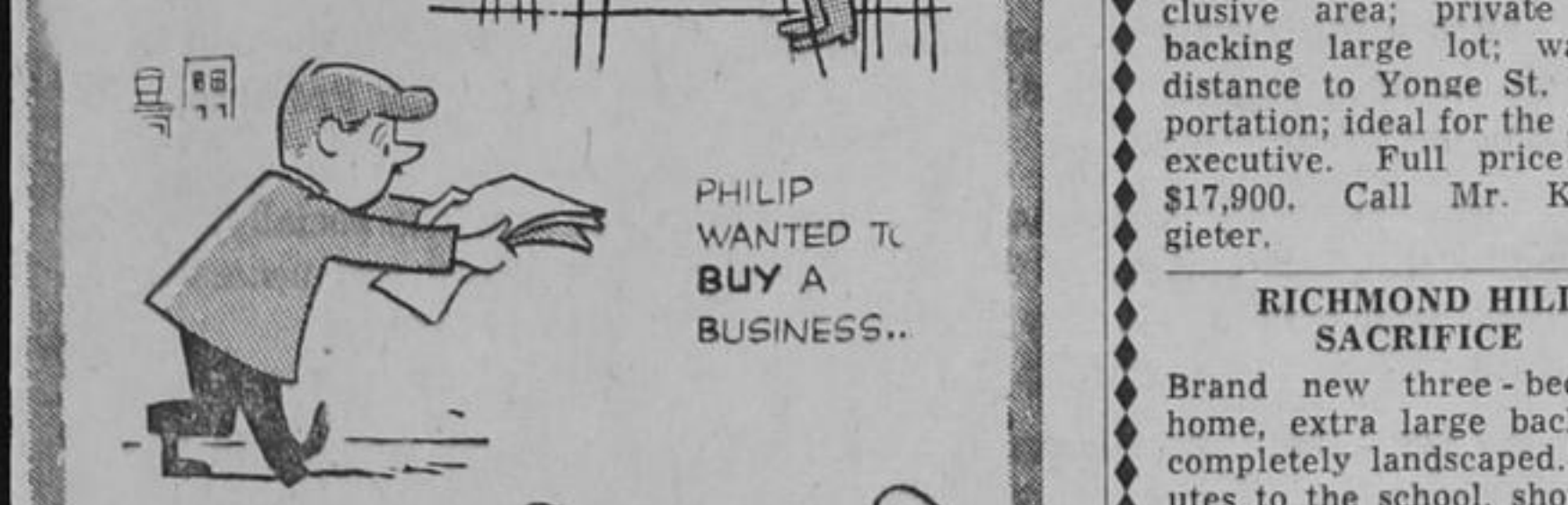

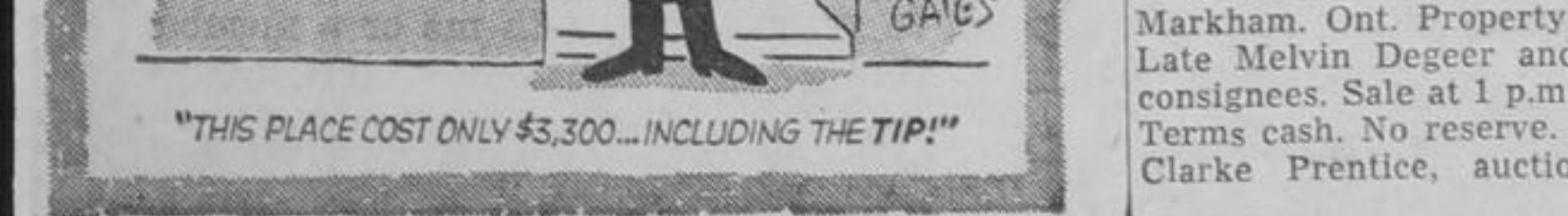

Planning Board Support Markham Plan Change

Richmond Hill Planning Board will support Markham Township's plans to have industrial land north of the town limits changed to agricultural under the township's official plan. This proposal, as well as others will be aired at a municipal board hearing Sept. 3, to inquire into Markham's amendment 23 to its official plan. The industrial land question became controversial last fall when land developer Murrice Mehlman told council of plans for a 257 acre industrial development north of Elgin Mills Road between Yonge Street and Bayview Avenue in Markham. Markham announced its opposition to the proposal unless Richmond Hill supplied and paid for services to the development. Developer Mehlman had requested the town to annex the area but this request was subsequently rejected.

Planning Board members were in the same mood Tuesday night when they said they were not interested in servicing the area unless the town annexed it. Town Planner Harold Deeks stated, "the town has no such plans at the moment but when and if it does it will decide what to do with the land at that time." Mr. Deeks said it was the board's view the land cannot be used for industrial purposes unless as a part of Richmond Hill. The area now is designated agriculture under Markham's zoning bylaw but is classed as industrial under its official plan. Board members felt the area should be designated as agricultural under Markham's official plan hereby forestalling any major development until such time it was considered feasible. Planner Deeks was ordered by the board to contact Markham officials and offer Richmond Hill's support at the municipal board hearing if desired.

Based on a minimum of \$1,500 an acre, services could cost to \$4,000.00 with the likelihood of the cost being shared by the town and the developer on a basis to be worked out at a later date.
